

ZSFG Inpatients with COVID-19: omicron wave







What Should We Expect at Level Red?

Inpatient	 PUI/COVID-19+ admitted patients cohorted on sixth floor (H64/H66/H68) Admitted patients cared for by 3 dedicated COVID-19 care teams (FIS-Purple, FIS-Green, FIS-Blue), adding an additional FMIS team, and using RIS teams 	
ICU	 PUI/COVID-19+ admitted patients cohorted on third floor (H38/H32) Open H46 to non-COVID-19 ICU patients Two dedicated MICU teams (Teams A and B) 	
ED/Urgent Care	 Separate respiratory triage area Cohort respiratory patients in Pod C UCC extends hours RFPC opens urgent care clinic to decompress UCC (Mon-Sat) 	
Outpatient clinics	 Non-urgent outpatient appointments rescheduled (or converted to telephone/tele-medicine visits). Goal of < 50% of baseline in-person clinic visits 	
OR/procedural areas/diagnostic studies	 Come and stay surgeries limited to < 8 surgeries/week Elective, non-urgent surgeries, procedures and diagnostic studies rescheduled. Goal of < 50% of baseline come and go surgeries/procedures (5 operating rooms utilized)
