Purpose of Agreement:

Civic Edge Consulting will work with SFDPH/PHD – Population Health and Emergency Preparedness and Response (PHEPR) Section to leverage department relationships with community-based organizations and neighborhood stakeholders. Civic Edge Consulting will conduct focus groups, individual interviews, and street outreach in order to collect data on community awareness and their preparation for both small and large scale emergencies.

Civic Edge Consulting will work with SFDPH to develop outreach strategies for collecting information. These strategies will include assessing the language needs of the community and the evaluation of current threshold languages to determine the appropriate messaging for each community, including stakeholders and residents.

Civic Edge will implement the appropriate qualitative survey tools, such as key informant interviews, focus groups, digital ethnography, and text messaging surveys that will allow for recommendations on communication

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dissemination methods that best meet the needs of the communities being evaluated. The neighborhood analysis and stakeholder mapping will identify populations who carry the heaviest burden and provide for the ability to further evaluate engagement strategies to reach each unique population.

Civic Edge will facilitate an overview to PHEPR leadership of the data collected that will provide for lessons learned, the use of strategies that can improve communication and messaging to the community, and the documentation methods used to connect with the various community members, including stake holders and residents.

Civic Edge Consulting was selected under RFQ2022-02 ranking number 1 under Service Area 1: Stakeholder Outreach Engagement and Facilitation Services.

Monitoring Report/Program Review & Follow-up:

Program leadership from the DPH System of Care, PHERP, will meet regularly with the Civic Edge team to discuss the feedback received and they will provide updates on the landscape analysis conducted by the Civic Edge will provide progress reports as part of the meeting to ensure that objectives and measurements are being met.

Additionally, this Agreement will have the following objectives monitored:

- Objective 1: Deliver Two Community Presentations

 Monitor: Review creative concepts to ensure that the community presentation meets DPH standards.
- Objective 2: Generate a Written Report

Monitor: A final report will be presented to DPH PHEPR leadership. Prior to the final report being presented a draft version will be required in order to evaluate. This review will ensure that all service points are included in the final presented report to DPH PHEPR leadership.
