10 interns supporting: Dental, Nutrition, Value Based Care (QI), Whole Person Integrated Care (WPIC)

DENTAL

Organize oral health screenings at SF Unified School District Kindergarten through 6th Grade programs

NUTRITION

Provide food on site to primary care patients with health conditions well-suited for dietary interventions with Food as Medicine

VALUE BASED CARE

Spearhead time-bound metric improvement projects to improve health care in areas prioritized by SFDPH and Medi-Cal for priority improvement efforts, e.g. blood pressure control and/or colorectal screening

WPIC

- Expand patient education materials and services to support clients staying at shelters in San Francisco in collaboration with the SFDPH Shelter Health Team.
- Streamline care coordination services processes with the SFDPH Permanent Housing Advanced Clinical Services Team (PHACS) team that brings medical and behavioral health services to clients in Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
- Improve coordination for Substance Use Services and Palliative Care Services with the SFDPH Street Medicine Team
- Work with the Maria X Martinez Health Resource Center on the Ending the HIV and Hepatitis C Epidemics to connect their site's clients with the appropriate resources and provide quality improvement support
