4. Report by Treasure Island Director

Bob Beck, Treasure Island Director, presented an update on development and operation issues. One Treasure Island, TIDA, TI Sailing Center, and Sailing Science Center will be hosting cleanup day from at Clipper Cove.

Hispanic Heritage Month celebration hosted by One Treasure Island on 9/27.

TIDA staff is working on preparing for Fleet Week and discouraging crowds.

Day to Night music festival on the weekend of 10/15.

New residents have begun moving in to Bristol on YBI.

Work is progressing on Star View Court.

First Private Parcel has completed driving piles and began excavation.

There were two power outages last month: 8/21 on YBI and 8/29 on TI. Service was restored in both cases in under two hours.

TIDA staff working with PUC on planned outages to upgrade systems.

On 8/11 the city made its first sale of bonds on the IRFD.

Environmental lawsuit was dismissed on 8/30.

Nella Goncalves, One Treasure Island, gave an update.

13th Cohort of Construction Training Program is in session with 12 participants.

Posters of the Oral History Project are in 35 bus stops spread throughout city.

Working with SFMTA on distributing information and getting resident feedback on Bay Skyway Project including new bike path and new ferry.

Planning for Halloween celebration.

Shiante Lewis, YMCA, gave an update.

Summer camp program completed.

After school program has 21 kids.

Partnering with One Treasure Island for fun Halloween events.

Relaunch of gym with brand new equipment and rebranding.

New youth programs are launching.

YMCA is open on Saturdays again.

Partnering with HSA on Veggie for Vouchers.

Director Tsen asked about YMCA photography program for youth.

Director Dunlop asked if the bond sale was up to expectations.

Director Richardson asked about the YBI power outage.

Michael Hennahane, Treasure Island Museum, commented on opening of new exhibit, "You Are Here: The Story of Treasure Island."
