AFFECTED PROPERTIES:

The SFPUC will be installing new equipment and/or performing maintenance in your area to ensure reliable service to all customers. In order to perform this work safely, the crew needs to temporarily interrupt your natural gas service, and will do its best to minimize the length of the service interruption.

If you are a Landlord with tenant(s) in the areas listed above and the SFPUC bill is in your name, it is your responsibility to notify the tenant(s) of the planned service interruption. It is also the Landlord's responsibility to re-light the tenants' pilot lights following the service interruption.

Unsafe weather conditions or any unforeseen emergency will require the Natural Gas Crew to cancel the work at the last minute and they will be unable to notify you of this cancellation. However, you will receive notification of the rescheduled date and time. The SFPUC apologizes for this inconvenience and thanks you for your patience.



For the Best Condo Perks, 'Nobody Does Amenities Better Than Hospitality' Brands, Says New Dev Consultant

...San Francisco's housing market has struggled these past few years. What's next for new developments there?

Nothing is getting built in this town, and the first project that will break ground will probably be late next year, maybe early the following year, so that means product won't be delivered until late in the decade. The city is expanding [developments] that have been in the pipeline for a decade or more.

Treasure Island [a manmade island off the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge] is going to build about 8,000 units of housing—apartments, condos and affordable housing. They just opened a gorgeous new waterfront park, and it's only an eight-minute ferry ride. The other one is Candlestick Park—it's where they ripped down the ballpark—they're seeking approvals to build thousands of units. That's an area where people had lived. Presidio Highlands, it's the old UCSF site, it's 10 acres—a primo area, it's really the best location. Half will be a park, and they'll build roughly 10 buildings, from senior living to apartments and condos. It's been in the works for 10 years of approvals....

SF: Restoration Ecologists Wage Quiet Battle For Biodiversity On Yerba Buena Island

Yerba Buena Island, the tall rock where the Bay Bridge ducks into a tunnel between San Francisco and Oakland, is home to one of the Bay Area's most overlooked ecological front lines.

Habitat Potential is a company of restoration ecologists that maintain the native landscape on the island and across San Francisco's signature parks, including Golden Gate Park and the Presidio.

"Doing environmental work, I mean, it would be so easy to get grim. You know, everything feels kind of hopeless and dismal," said the company's founder Josiah Clark at the end of a long work day clearing eucalyptus leaves from a wooded area on Yerba Buena Island. "But I think that there's enough beauty and productivity and robustness in nature to kind of carry the story through."

After his 10-hour days delivering for DoorDash, Sasha Arapinovich sits in his backyard admiring the view of San Francisco's skyline shimmering across the water. On those breezy fall nights, with little noise beyond the rustle of palm trees, he feels like he hit the housing lottery.

"I really couldn't have imagined a better situation for myself," said Arapinovich, a Belarusian immigrant who pays \$625 a month for his room in a two-story town house toward the back of a former military base.
