- Civil Work Modification to sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drainage, and utility relocation as needed. Installation of landscaping, fencing, lighting, and signage.
- Signal Work Removal or modification of existing signal systems and/or installation of new signals, including installation of signal conduits and other necessary work to ensure proper functioning of the Caltrain signal system.
- Station Work Rehabilitation and maintenance of train station platforms. Modernization of stations by adding or improving passenger waiting areas, ticket vending machines, passenger shelters, bike lockers, fencings, railings, signs, and electronic readers and messaging, security cameras, lighting, PA systems, and Americans with Disabilities (ADA) upgrades and compliance measures.
- At grade crossing safety improvements Improvements includes widening of sidewalks, markers and marking, signage, channelization and signaling, quad gates and exit gates.
