

## 2025-2026 COMMUNITY GRANTS RFP INTENT TO APPLY RESULTS

This document provides the results of the Intent to Apply process for the 2025–2026 Community Grants Request for Proposals (RFP). The Intent to Apply process was used to verify applicant compliance with the Minimum Qualifications (MQs) required for this RFP before proposals could be submitted. As part of this process, proposers submitted information about their proposed program(s) and uploaded documentation to demonstrate compliance with MQs.

The tables below list the agencies and programs that met the MQs for this RFP and are therefore eligible to submit a proposal, as well as those that did not meet the MQs. All applicants will receive an email with DCYF’s Intent to Apply determination. Applicants who met the MQs will receive access to DCYF’s online RFP system and may submit proposals between **December 12, 2025 and January 5, 2026**.

Applicants who did not meet the MQs are not eligible to submit a proposal. However, they may file a protest of DCYF’s determination as outlined below.

### PROTEST OF INTENT TO APPLY DETERMINATION

Applicants may submit a Protest of Intent to Apply determination within three (3) business days of this notice. The protest period **runs from Monday, November 24 through Monday, December 1, 2025, at 5:00PM**. Protests must include::

- Agency name and name of the proposal being protested
- A detailed written statement specifying the grounds for protest, citing any relevant law, rule, or solicitation provision
- Supporting facts and evidence for the City’s review
- Signature of an authorized representative

Protests must be submitted electronically to [RFP@dcyf.org](mailto:RFP@dcyf.org) before the protest period ends. A DCYF-selected panel will review all eligible protests, and its decision will be final.
