## Legally Required Bodies

- Most bodies have legal duties under Charter or local codes
- 27 bodies identified with state or federal mandates (“legally required”)

| Number | Scenario  | Impact  |
|--------|---|---|
| 16     | Body is required by state or federal law                  | May not eliminate body; may be possible to explore consolidation                              |
| 11     | Body fulfills a function required by state or federal law | Must find a suitable alternative to carry out legally required function in order to eliminate |

- 2 bodies have membership/ appointment details prescribed by state law

## Notes:

1. Required as long as the City receives Community Corrections Performance Incentives funds
2. Borderline inactive. Will be discussed at 8/20 meeting.
3. Must exist under state law, but no requirement to be established in Charter or any City ordinance
4. Required as long as TIDA is incorporated as a nonprofit
5. Appointments and membership constrained by state law
6. Required functions can only be transferred to another board or commission under narrow circumstances
