I urge you to reject the proposals that would weaken the authority of the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Commission (JPC), especially with respect to hiring, budget, contracts, and policies. The JPC's independent oversight powers are what has allowed it to play such a key role in safeguarding justice-involved youth and ensuring there is real accountability and transparency in their treatment. Taking away that authority risks losing the reforms that the JPC has implemented to ensure equitable treatment and set youth up for the greatest chance of success. Please do not alter the JPC's independent oversight authority.
