Dear Chair Harrington and task force members,

Thank you for your service to our city on the Commission Streamlining Taskforce.

I would like to express concern over the proposed removal of the Mission Bay Transportation Improvement Fund.

The Mission Bay neighborhood is a thriving, mixed-use community with biotech companies, offices, retail, world class entertainment, and thousands of residents. The neighborhood has welcomed the Chase Center with the understanding that additional transportation, police, and cleaning services would be needed to both meet the demand of events and maintain high quality services for existing residents and businesses. Thus, a "lockbox" fund was established with the intent of supplementing city services and protecting that funding for that purpose. The CAC was formed to ensure that fund expenditures were subject to robust community input. In fact, the formation of the CAC was a key community promise made as part of the development agreement for the Chase Center.

The recommendation focuses heavily on transportation, but the CAC also provides valuable recommendations to the Public Works and Police Department. The recommendations also do not recognize that Chase Center operations have only intensified since the venue opened. With a new Women's Professional Basketball team and a growing slate of entertainment and sporting events, there is an ongoing need for community input on the deployment of city resources. With a shortfall in SFMTA funds for upcoming budget years, the need to refine projections and creatively plan for the future is needed now more than ever.

I look forward to discussing the need and opportunities for this advisory committee.
