My name is Evan Sirchuk, I am a resident and registered voter of San Francisco (District 1).

I am writing to express my support for the Commission on the Status of Women (COSW).

San Francisco is well known as a hub for technological leaps, but those technologies often disregard women's perspectives and make their lives worse.

Right now AI technologies are coded with female names and placed in conventionally female roles, but are largely coded by men. This technology reinforces toxic stereotypes and constraining gender roles.
