My name is Vicky Huang and I am an employee at the California Academy of Sciences and a resident of San Francisco. As an educator who works closely with San Francisco high school youth, I am writing to encourage you to keep the Youth Commission in the City Charter as a chartered advisory commission to protect independent youth voices in City Hall.

I ask that you reject any considerations that would impose a sunset date, remove youth seats, or implement unnecessary term limits, and remove language that prohibits youth commissioners from receiving compensation for their public service. The Youth Commission is the only youth-led, youth-focused chartered city commission in San Francisco, and youth voices deserve to be heard.
