Chair Harrington and Members of the Commission Streamlining Task Force:

I write in regards to Item 5 on the November 5, 2025 agenda, wherein the Commission will consider the recommendation to eliminate the Sweatfree Procurement Advisory Group (SPAG) and provide direction to staff and the City Attorney's Office for drafting legislation.

At your August 20, 2025 Task Force meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to defer the decision, pending the Board of Supervisor's action to ensure that the Advisory Group is operable.

As a result, on September 17, 2025, the Board of Supervisors' Budget and Finance Committee considered and passed legislation to restore the Sweatfree Procurement Advisory Group in perpetuity. On October 7, 2025, the Board unanimously passed the legislation, which was later signed by the Mayor on October 16, 2025.

Due to both the decision by the Task Force to defer this item and decisive action taken by the Board of Supervisors, I respectfully request that the Task Force remove the recommendation to eliminate the SPAG.
