Dear Commissioners,

I believe that at the last meeting it was agreed that the Street Artists Program would remain with the San Francisco Arts Commission. That it is the best agency to administer the Arts and Crafts Program.

If the Street Artists and Crafts Examiners Advisory Committee is to be terminated, then its responsibilities for screening new Artists (and insuring that the work is “handmade”) could be handled “in house” by the staff at the SFAC who already run the Program. As long as the basic integrity of the Program (“handmade” by the Artist) is maintained then the original intent of Proposition J (1974) is carried out.

This is a good solution for the Commission’s review of City agencies.
