- **SFO Mission**: Delivering an airport experience where people and our planet come first.





North America Performance:

- 12th Busiest U.S. Airport (2023)
- Top Large U.S. Airport (2022): The Wall Street Journal ranked SFO as the top large U.S. airport based on factors like ontime performance, security checkpoint wait times, and customer satisfaction.
- Best Airport in North America (2022 & 2024): SFO was named the Best Airport in North America by Airports Council International (ACI) for customer experience and by Business Traveler Magazine.
- One of the top 10 Best Large U.S. Airports (2023): The Wall Street Journal included SFO in its list of the 10 Best Large U.S. Airports for 2023.

Economic Performance:

- Bay Area's Busiest Airport
- **\$6.1B Business Revenue** (FY2020/21).
- 28,000 on-airport jobs (FY2020/21) with estimates of double that amount for off-airport jobs.


Global Performance:

Capital Program \$11B Includes but not limited to:


- 1. Terminal 3 West

Future Major Projects

Capital Program exceeding \$15-20B according to current estimates to accommodate 71 million passenger annually. Some of the major projects includes but not limited to:

- 4. Central Garage Redevelopment
- Domestic roadway replacement and expansion
- 6. Catering Facility improvements

Securing Airport's Future:


- Provide adequate international aircraft terminal gates

Securing Airport's Future:


- Provide adequate close in parking for passengers

- 3. Renewing campus wide electrical network




Future Projects: Electrical Utilities Development

Demand Load vs. Year Per Category




Future Projects: Rental Parking Development


