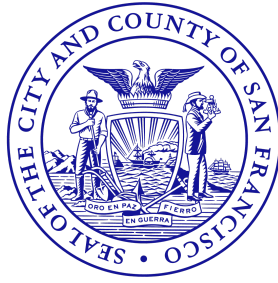

Dear Chair Harrington and Vice Chair Andrea Bruss,

Thank you for your service to our city on the Commission Streamlining Taskforce.

I am writing to request that the Commission Streamlining Task Force re-evaluate their recommendation to eliminate the Mission Bay Transportation Improvement Fund Community Advisory Committee.

The Mission Bay neighborhood is a thriving, mixed-use community with biotech companies, offices, retail, world class entertainment, and thousands of residents. The neighborhood has welcomed the Chase Center with the understanding that additional transportation, police, and cleaning services would be needed to both meet the demand of events and maintain high quality services for existing residents and businesses. Thus, a fund and an accompanying CAC was established with the intent of supplementing city services and providing oversight of service levels.

The legislation establishing the fund and the CAC clearly states they shall both exist as long as events are held at The Chase Center. In addition to Warriors home games, the Chase Center is hosting more events each year ranging from concerts to Valkyries games to other athletic events. The CAC's role in overseeing city service levels is as important as ever.

As a member of the budget committee, I am keenly aware of the budget deficit and the difficult decisions that will be made in the coming months. The fund and CAC will be valuable

assets for transparency and discussion. Their duty and utility remains, regardless of the accounting mechanism for funding services.

The Mission Bay TIF CAC is working as intended. The CAC members provide valuable feedback to city departments who continue to adjust their service levels and budget modeling. The intent of the establishing legislation could not be clearer - the CAC should continue its work.

My office has met with departments and Mission Bay stakeholders over the last few months, and we are ready to share information and insights with the task force.
