Hello,

I would just like to reiterate that I do not believe the "Sunset Dates" section of the draft report clearly explains what happens after 3 years. Stating that it is customary that the Board now sets 3-year sunset dates for new groups doesn't explain what happens. Do groups cease to exist by default unless the board takes action? If yes, that will be of concern for groups that were previously in the Charter and are being recommended to be moved to the Admin code.

I have heard a fair amount of concern about the Commission on the Environment in this respect, as it's a group that does not believe it should cease to exist by default. Current language provided on what it means to have a "sunset date" is still confusing.
