

PUBLIC COMMENT DAY ON THE ANNUAL BUDGET

Budget and Appropriations Committee

Wednesday, June 24, 2026, starting at 10:00 a.m.

The Chair of the Budget and Appropriations Committee has scheduled Public Comment Day on the Annual Budget for **Wednesday, June 24, 2025, at 10:00 a.m.** This will be the public's opportunity to provide their testimony on the Proposed Appropriation and Annual Salary Ordinances for the Fiscal Years 2026-2027 and 2027-2028 (File Nos. [260596](#) and [260597](#)). Time Allotted for Each Speaker: One (1) Minute

Consecutive interpretation services will be available in Chinese, Spanish, and Filipino from 10:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m., and our interpreters are on standby to provide language assistance during the meeting.

In-Person Attendance/Public Comment

Those wishing to provide in-person Public Comment **must either line up inside the Chamber, or outside the rear Chamber doors, within the stanchions** posted outside the Legislative Chamber, Room 250, and running the length of the hallways throughout the 2nd Floor. The Sheriffs/staff will admit speakers as space permits. When entering the Chamber from the hallway line, please continue to the inside-Chamber line. Staff will be on hand to guide the line and answer any questions.

The doors to the Legislative Chamber will be opened at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the meeting. Chamber seating will be prioritized for those with special needs. **Members of the public with special needs may enter through the middle Chamber doors.** We encourage those who require special accommodations - such as those with a disability, the elderly, or persons with young children (under age 5) - to arrive early for seating on a first-come-first-served basis. ADA seating will be available at the front rows of the Legislative Chamber. The Budget Chair will make periodic announcements to prioritize and call up individuals seated in the Chamber with accommodation needs to provide public comment.

Vacant seats will be filled on a first-come first-served order, and may not be reserved. Chamber seating will be prioritized for those with special needs. Members of the public are requested to exit the chamber after their public comment is made. Observation and overflow seating will be available in Committee Room 263 (2nd Floor).

Only one person is allowed at the podium at any given time to speak, unless they require interpretation or if an individual is speaking on behalf of an entire group (see below for more direction on Group Public Comment). Board procedures prohibit saving seats or standing idly (not in line) in the Chamber.

Presentations (i.e. slides, videos, documents) may be shown during an individual's comment time, but it must abide by the one (1) minute limit and the individual displaying the video may not make an additional personal comment. *Each person may only speak once, regardless of whether they are part of multiple groups or speaking on behalf of any group.*

Group Public Comment (In-Person):

- One individual attendee may speak on behalf of an entire group
- Groups are required to stay together in line
- When the allotted speaking time is over, the entire group must exit the Chamber

After providing Public Comment, speakers attending in-person will be required to exit the Chamber. After exiting the Chamber, individuals are welcome to view the remainder of the proceedings from the designated observation areas.

Remote Access

Members of the public can watch Board and Committee proceedings by attending in-person, or by watching on SFGovTV. Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order 1.3.3 does not permit remote public comment by members of the public at meetings of the Board and its committees, except as legally required to enable people with disabilities to participate in such meetings. If you require remote access as a means of reasonable accommodation under ADA, please contact the Office of the Clerk of the Board at (415) 554-5814 to request remote access, including a description of the functional limitation(s) that precludes your ability to attend in person.

Interpretation Services

Interpretation services will be available in Chinese, Spanish, and Filipino from **10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** Limited English Proficient individuals are encouraged to attend and line up to speak early in the day. They will be allotted one (1) minute - the same as all Public Commenters - to provide comment in their language; after which the interpreter will restate that testimony in English.
