




TREASURE ISLAND LANDING

- Views back to San Francisco
- Ferry Terminal structure and pier
- Intermodal transit hub -- a space of activity
- Includes Waterfront Plaza + Causeway Park

TRANS-PACIFIC PLAZA

Building 1

- Historic structures (administrative building and air control tower)
- Historic date palms
- Pacific Unity sculptures

CLIPPER COVE PLAZA (MARINA PLAZA) ACLA





CLIPPER COVE PLAZA

- Stage, seating, and gathering spaces
- Access to Building 1
- Proximity to Clipper Cove

PAN AM GROVE (BUILDING 2 PLAZA) CMG





PAN AM GROVE

- Former Pan-Am hanger and exhibition space (1939-1945)
- Transplanted olive trees cared for by the Bruccia Family (planted by Giuseppe Bruccia for the GGIE)
- 'Hall of Air Transportation' during the GGIE
- 'Spirit of Transportation' bas-relief figure on facade
- Building dedicated to "Men with Wings of Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow"
- Views of Building 1 and Clipper Cove

THE HANGAR YARD

- Between historic hangers 2 and 3
- Event space
- China Clipper
- Live Oaks and Ginkgo trees
- 'Palace of Fine and Decorative Arts' during GGIE
- Former home to Diego Rivera's 'Pan Am Unity' fresco mural
- Used by the Navy as repair facility and port control office
- Art Moderne architectural style
- Views of Bay Bridge and Clipper Cove

- Multi-use pathway/Bay Trail
- Proximity to Marina and Clipper Cove

- Historic chapel (re-purposed for civic functions)
- Lawn area with space for performances and gathering
- Bosque of trees
- Previously used as a wedding venue

- Views to SF skyline and Golden Gate Bridge
- Experience of night-time city lights
- Western exposure/dramatic climate: sunsets, wind, fog
- Length (1/2 mile) and expansiveness
- Identity as a large regional park
- Programmatic Rooms/Windrows
- Bay Trail

THE COMMON

- Multi-use pathway
- Continuous grove of elm trees
- Neighborhood adjacency
- Programmatic rooms in series
- Linearity
