RESOLUTION TO RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GIFT OF \$480,000 FROM BREAKING THE CYCLE THROUGH THE HOMES FOR THE HOMELESS FUND LLC, A SUBSIDIARY OF THE HOUSING ACCELERATOR FUND

WHEREAS, The Breaking the Cycle (BtC), through a fiscal intermediary, Homes for the Homeless Fund LLC, a subsidiary of the Housing Accelerator Fund, has awarded to the Department of Public Health (DPH) a gift in the amount of \$480,000 for participation in a program, entitled “Breaking the Cycle Gift – Long-Acting Injectable (LAI) Buprenorphine Purchase Funding”; and

WHEREAS, Homes for the Homeless Fund LLC (HHF), a California limited liability company and wholly owned subsidiary of the Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF), seeks to provide \$480,000 of Breaking the Cycle (BtC) philanthropic funding to DPH to enable DPH’s purchase of Long-Acting Injectable (LAI) buprenorphine, which it will make available over a 24-month period at four City clinics; and

WHEREAS, HAF, in the role of fiscal intermediary for BtC, makes this gift through HHF; and

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received notification of the gift on December 29, 2025; and

WHEREAS, DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the gift funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Core Initiatives, Section 21B.4; and, be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission authorizes the Department of Public Health to accept and expend the gift of up to four hundred and eighty thousand dollars (\$480,000) from the Breaking the Cycle, through a fiscal intermediary, Homes for the Homeless Fund LLC for participation in a program, entitled “Breaking the Cycle Gift – Long-Acting Injectable (LAI) Buprenorphine Purchase Funding,” pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Health Commission authorizes the Department of Public Health to retroactively accept and expend the gift funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Core Initiatives, Section 21B.4.
