**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND GIFTS OF
\$12,710.44, \$115,000, AND \$37,500 FROM THE EPIC SYSTEMS CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, The Epic Systems Corporation provides for the distribution of twelve thousand seven hundred ten dollars and forty-four cents (\$12,710.44), one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000), and thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$37,500); and

WHEREAS, The Epic Safety Net Program comprises hospitals, clinics, emergency medical service treatment providers, and affiliate and contract treatment providers, all of which are under the Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, The Epic Systems Corporation has donated to the Department of Public Health in the amounts of \$12,710.44, \$115,000 and \$37,500 for the department's role as a Safety Net provider; and

WHEREAS, The Epic Systems Corporation provides gifts to entities that help low income and at-risk populations; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission authorizes the Department of Public Health to accept and expend gifts of cash of twelve thousand seven hundred ten dollars and forty-four cents (\$12,710.44), one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000) and thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$37,500) to support the goal of helping low income and at-risk populations; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the gift will be accepted and expended consistent with San Francisco Administrative Code Sections governing the acceptance of gifts to the City and County of San Francisco, including San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.100-305.
