RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GIFT OF \$799,053 FROM THE SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC HEALTH FOUNDATION

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Health Foundation has awarded to the Department of Public Health a gift in the amount of \$799,053 for the Breaking the Cycle Ops Fellowship; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Health Foundation has notified the Department of Public Health that proceeds from the gift will be distributed; and

WHEREAS, The gift will be in the form of funding to fund two existing Fellowship positions that will help to execute high-impact operational projects for San Francisco's Breaking the Cycle Initiative (BTC); and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Health Foundation provides gifts to entities that help low income and at-risk populations; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission authorizes the Department of Public Health to accept and expend the gift of up to seven hundred ninety-nine thousand fifty-three dollars (\$799,053) to help implement operational projects for the BTC; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the gift will be accepted and expended consistent with San Francisco Administrative Code Sections governing the acceptance of gifts to the City and County of San Francisco, including San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.100-201.
