**RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC HEALTH TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GIFT OF \$118,800 FROM WELCOME BABY USA INC**

WHEREAS, The Welcome Baby USA Inc organization will donate to the Department of Public Health an in-kind gift in the amount of \$118,800 for the Ambulatory Care Team; and

WHEREAS, The Welcome Baby USA Inc organization has notified the Department of Public Health that proceeds from the gift will be distributed; and

WHEREAS, The gift will be in the form of boxes of diapers, wipes and other baby supplies for newborns; and

WHEREAS, The Welcome Baby USA Inc organization provides low-income mothers with one comprehensive package containing everything she and her newborn need in the first four weeks of life; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission recommends that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Department of Public Health to accept and expend an in-kind gift of up to one hundred eighteen thousand eight hundred (\$118,800) to help low-income mothers; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the gift will be accepted and expended consistent with San Francisco Administrative Code Sections governing the acceptance of gifts to the City and County of San Francisco, including San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.100-201.
