HONORING JENNY LOUIE

WHEREAS, Jenny Louie has served the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF), and the Department of Public Health as an exceptional leader; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Louie began her City and County of San Francisco tenure at the San Francisco Arts Commission as a Program Manager in 2000 and then transitioned to a Fiscal and Policy Analyst position in 2006, serving in this role under Mayor Gavin Newsom; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Louie joined the Department of Public Health (DPH) in 2008; and held a succession of managerial positions with increased responsibility, including the DPH Budget Manager; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Louie was appointed as the DPH Chief Financial Officer in 2021. During her tenure in this position, Ms. Louie led the development of DPH's annual budget as well as supported such major initiatives as the transition to the Affordable Care Act; the rollout of EPIC, the DPH electronic health record system; Mental Health SF; and implementation of major Medi-Cal Programs including Whole Person Care and CalAIM, and the COVID-19 response; and

WHEREAS, After being appointed Chief Operating Officer of DPH in 2024, Ms. Louie oversaw the finances and administrative operations of the City's largest department, including Zuckerberg San Francisco General and Laguna Honda Hospitals, and a citywide network of primary care, mental health, and substance use programs, in addition to the many Population Health Division programs; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Louie has ensured the prioritization of the department's true north pillars of health impact, workforce investment, safety and security, financial stewardship, equity and service experience; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Louie is known for her generosity of time, support, problem-solving and leadership while moving her staff and DPH towards operational excellence; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Louie has built a legacy of service and leadership to support and improve the lives of all San Franciscans. She will be dearly missed by many at the DPH and in the greater San Francisco public health communities.

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Health Commission honors Jenny Louie for her outstanding service and effective leadership, and wishes her well in her future endeavors.
