**AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE A
RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY FOR THE ELDERLY AT 624 LAGUNA STREET AND TO APPOINT AN
ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE FACILITY**

WHEREAS, The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) licenses Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly (RCFEs), which are facilities that provide much-needed care, supervision, and support for older adults; and

WHEREAS, In order to expand the number of RCFE beds in San Francisco, the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFPDH) wishes to apply for a state RCFE license; and

WHEREAS, State law requires that applicants for RCFE licenses file an application form with CDSS, and provide verification and documentation as requested; and

WHEREAS, When an applicant for a RCFE license is a government entity, CDSS requires that the applicant submit evidence that it is authorized to apply for the license, such as a resolution from its Governing Body ; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission of the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes SFPDH to submit an application to CDSS for a license to operate an RCFE located at 624 Laguna Street, San Francisco, California; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission of the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes SFPDH to appoint an Administrator for this facility.
