Though they have addressed its impactful programming and identified barriers. It remains unclear to the transformative justice process that they are trying to achieve. However, it is unclear in regards to their responsivity in urgent situations (crisis interventions, emergency housing, mental health responsivity). With these addressed this could give TJIP a more comprehensive overview of their organizations not just with political perspectives but could be a more robust model for communities they serve.	14
