

GFTA Appeals Process

Appeals are only allowed if there was an error in, or violation of, the published review process. Applicant mistakes, incomplete applications, or disagreement with the funding decision are not grounds for appeal.

Valid grounds include:

- Use of criteria not in the guidelines
- Undisclosed conflicts of interest
- Knowingly incorrect information used in the review

To start, request your application scorecard from your assigned program officer or GFTA@sfgov.org.

To file an appeal, submit a signed letter on organizational letterhead to the GFTA Director within 15 calendar days, citing evidence of a valid appeal ground. The Director's decision is final.
