RE: MOHCD Senior Operating Subsidy (SOS) Policies & Procedures Manual

1. Background – MOHCD's Senior Operating Subsidy Policies and Procedures Manual

In July 2019, the Board of Supervisors (BOS) established the Senior Operating Subsidy Program Fund ("SOS Program Fund") for the purpose of providing project-based subsidies to new and rehabilitated senior affordable housing developments funded by the City through MOHCD. The Fund has since been expanded by a \$52 million grant from the State of California.

The Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD")'s Senior Operating Subsidy Policies and Procedures Manual ("SOS Policy Manual") is intended to assist applicants ("Sponsors") for capital financing to prepare financing requests to the City and County of San Francisco (the "City"), represented by the Mayor, acting by and through MOHCD. This SOS Policy Manual will also be used by MOHCD staff to evaluate SOS funding requests and presenting them to the Citywide Affordable Housing Loan Committee ("Loan Committee") for consideration. The intent of the SOS Policy Manual is to support consistency of SOS Program terms across projects and to ensure long-term affordability and physical and financial sustainability throughout a project's loan term. This SOS Policy Manual covers policy and procedures for new and rehabilitated senior affordable housing development projects financed by MOHCD utilizing the SOS Program.

The Loan Committee maintains the right to set final terms and conditions for a commitment of funds based on the actual circumstances of each project. MOHCD may review and approve any requests for a waiver to this SOS Policy Manual (see Section VII) in its sole and absolute discretion.

The SOS Policy Manual will be updated from time to time. Public comment for this policy manual was solicited from over 950 stakeholders in June-July 2023, with 42 written comments received from six parties, including affordable housing developers and sister City Departments.

2. This Request

This request is to approve MOHCD's inaugural SOS Policy Manual (effective as of the date of Loan Committee approval) which describes requirements and procedures governing the SOS Program to ensure that eligible household applicants are selected for the SOS Program designated units, receive the proper subsidy, and are treated fairly and consistently. This manual includes guidelines that:

- align certain parts of the SOS Policy Manual with the recently published Underwriting Guidelines including Budgeting,
- align certain parts of the SOS Policy Manual with the Marketing Template and Housing Preferences and Lottery Procedures Manual,
- align certain parts of the SOS Policy Manual to reflect the City's racial equity goals.

The proposed manual can be found in Attachment A.

3. Summary of Manual

Key elements of the manual include:

- Sizing of the subsidy request as follows:
 - Up to 40% of project units may be assisted by SOS. SOS subsidy applied pari pasu across unit sizes.
 - 50% of the Assisted Units with a per unit subsidy amount equal to the difference between (i) 30% of 60% AMI (less utility allowance), and (ii) 30% of 25% AMI (less utility allowance).
 - 50% of Assisted Units with a per unit subsidy amount equal to the difference between (i) 30% of 60% AMI (less utility allowance), and (ii) 30% of 15% AMI (less utility allowance).
 - Annual escalation at 4%.
- Explanation of process for application for funds, securing a grant agreement, annual disbursement of funds, and annual monitoring.
- Establishment of minimum compliance standards and SOS Lease Addendum.
- Identification of process for requesting department waivers.

4. Staff Recommendation

This proposed SOS Policy Manual maintains a consistency of the Senior Operating Subsidy Program terms across projects and ensures long-term affordability and physical and financial sustainability throughout a project's grant term. The Manual reflects our commitments for our funding review and expediting applications, including alignment with our Underwriting Guidelines. This Manual does not supersede any requirements under the MOHCD Underwriting Guidelines.

MOHCD Staff recommends Loan Committee approval of the SOS Policy Manual as proposed in Attachment A (clean version).
