Artist Biography (Please provide a short biography about yourself and your craft):

I am a self-taught artist based in San Francisco, creating handcrafted objects that exist at the intersection of memory, emotion, and everyday ritual. My work is shaped by my journey as an immigrant from India, where I grew up surrounded by handmade textures, quiet details, and objects that carried meaning beyond their function. By profession, I am a product manager, designing experiences for people at scale. Through my art, I return to the opposite—slowing down to create something intimate, tactile, and deeply personal. I approach each piece not just as an object, but as a small experience: something to be held, used, and lived with over time. I work with materials such as epoxy resin, Jesmonite, ceramic-based casting compounds, and hand-poured wax to create trinket trays, jewelry dishes, decorative bowls, and sculptural candles. I am drawn to organic forms—shells, florals, and soft silhouettes—and muted palettes that evoke calm and quiet presence. Each piece is individually cast, sanded, and hand-finished, carrying subtle variations that reflect the human hand behind it. My work is rooted in the idea of keepsakes—objects that hold moments, whether it's a piece of jewelry at the end of the day or a gift exchanged between loved ones. Through my practice, I hope to create small anchors of memory—pieces that invite pause, connection, and a sense of home in a fast-moving world.

1. Describe the items you plan to sell and how each type of item is made. Please be as detailed as possible. Example: I plan to sell digital photographic prints of artwork that I designed in Illustrator and printed on cardstock using a home printer.

I create handcrafted home décor and functional art pieces including trinket trays, jewelry dishes, decorative bowls, and sculptural candles. Each item is individually designed and made by hand using materials such as epoxy resin and epoxy ceramic (Jesmonite-style casting compounds), as well as natural waxes for candle work. For my trays, dishes, and bowls, I begin by selecting or designing molds inspired by organic forms such as shells, florals, and abstract shapes. I carefully measure and mix epoxy resin or epoxy ceramic compounds, incorporating pigments to achieve soft, muted tones. The material is then poured into molds and left to cure. Once hardened, each piece is removed, hand-sanded to smooth edges and surfaces, and refined to ensure both durability and finish quality. After shaping, I hand-finish each piece using sealing and detailing techniques. Some pieces are further enhanced with hand-applied metallic accents, such as gold leaf, to add texture and visual depth. Each item is sealed to protect the surface and ensure longevity. For candles, I use beeswax, soy wax, or a blend of both, depending on the desired finish and burn quality. I melt and pour the wax into molds or prepared forms, ensuring proper wick placement, curing time, and structural integrity. Each candle is finished and inspected by hand. No two pieces are identical, as each reflects subtle variations from the handmade process. All products are created entirely by me, from raw materials to final finish, and I do not resell or use pre-manufactured decorative items.

2. Where did you learn your craft? Did you take a class or learn on your own?

I am primarily a self-taught artist who developed my craft through hands-on experimentation, research, and continuous practice. My journey began as a personal creative outlet, where I explored materials such as epoxy resin, epoxy ceramic compounds, and natural waxes to understand their properties, behavior, and potential. Through trial and error, I learned



techniques such as precise measuring and mixing, mold preparation, casting, curing, sanding, and surface finishing. I have also expanded my skills through online tutorials, maker communities, and by studying the work of artists in the handmade home décor and functional art space. My upbringing in India has influenced my approach to craft, where I was exposed to handmade objects and traditional techniques that emphasized patience, detail, and intentional creation. This background continues to inform my aesthetic and appreciation for slow, thoughtful making. Over time, I have developed my own style focused on organic forms, calming color palettes, and objects designed for everyday use and meaningful gifting. I continue to experiment with new materials, finishes, and forms to refine my work. This combination of self-directed learning, cultural influence, and consistent practice has allowed me to build a body of work that reflects both technical skill and personal expression.

What distinguishes my work is the way I approach each piece not just as an object, but as a small, intentional experience. Coming from a background in product management, I think deeply about how people interact with objects in their everyday lives—how something is held, where it sits in a space, and the emotional role it plays over time. This perspective informs both the design and function of my work. As an immigrant from India, my aesthetic is also shaped by a blend of cultural influences—traditional appreciation for handmade craft, modern, minimal approach to form and color. I focus on creating pieces that feel soft,



and versatile, using organic shapes and muted palettes that integrate seamlessly into different environments. Materiality is another key differentiator. I work with a combination of epoxy resin, epoxy ceramic compounds, and natural waxes such as beeswax and soy wax, allowing me to explore both structural and sculptural qualities in my pieces. Each item is individually cast, finished, and detailed by hand, ensuring that no two pieces are identical. Finally, my work is rooted in the idea of keepsakes—objects designed to hold meaning, whether used daily or given as a gift. Rather than creating purely decorative items, I aim to create pieces that people form a quiet, personal connection with over time.

10. How are you ensuring customers can tell a difference between your work and commercial or mass-produced items?

I ensure that customers can clearly distinguish my work from commercial or mass-produced items through both the visible qualities of the finished pieces and the transparency of my process. Each item I create is individually handcrafted from raw materials such as epoxy resin, epoxy ceramic compounds, and natural waxes like beeswax and soy wax. Because of this, every piece carries subtle variations in texture, finish, and form that are inherent to handmade work. These small differences are intentional and visible, allowing customers to recognize that no two pieces are identical. I also maintain a design language that reflects organic, imperfect forms—such as shells, florals, and soft silhouettes—rather than uniform, machine-perfect shapes typically found in mass production. Hand-applied details, including sanding, finishing, and metallic accents like gold leaf, further emphasize the human touch behind each piece. In addition, I communicate my process openly through product descriptions and in-person interactions, explaining the materials and techniques involved in making each item. I



share how the pieces are cast, finished, and assembled by hand, which helps customers understand the level of craftsmanship involved. Together, the visible uniqueness of each item and the transparency of my handmade process ensure that customers can easily differentiate my work from commercially manufactured products.

11. What steps have you taken to ensure that you are not violating any copyright or other laws?

I ensure that all of my work is original and created entirely by me, from concept to finished product. My designs are developed from my own ideas and inspirations, focusing on organic forms such as shells, florals, and abstract shapes, rather than copying or reproducing the work of other artists, brands, or copyrighted designs. I do not use licensed characters, logos, brand names, or imagery in my work, and I avoid replicating distinctive or trademarked designs. Any molds, tools, or materials I use are either commercially available for general use or are adapted in a way that results in original, hand-finished pieces. I am mindful of copyright and intellectual property laws and make a conscious effort to ensure that my products reflect my own creative expression. In addition, I accurately represent my work as handmade and do not resell or misrepresent commercially manufactured goods as my own. From a business and regulatory standpoint, I am committed to complying with all applicable local and state requirements in San Francisco and California, including obtaining necessary permits, following sales tax regulations, and adhering to product safety considerations—particularly for candle-making, where I use appropriate materials and safe construction practices. 14. Describe the safety procedures you use in your craft. What, if any, safety equipment do you use? How do you store and handle any toxic or hazardous material?

I follow careful safety procedures when working with materials such as epoxy resin, epoxy ceramic compounds, and candle-making waxes to ensure both personal safety and a clean working environment. When handling epoxy resin and casting materials, I wear appropriate personal protective equipment including nitrile gloves, protective eyewear, and a mask or respirator to minimize exposure to fumes and fine particles. I work in a well-ventilated area to ensure proper air circulation, especially during mixing, pouring, and curing processes. I measure and mix materials according to manufacturer guidelines to ensure safe handling and proper curing. All tools and surfaces are cleaned immediately after use to prevent resin buildup. For candle-making, I carefully monitor temperatures while melting beeswax to prevent overheating. I use heat-safe containers and maintain a controlled workspace to



reduce any risk of burns or fire hazards. Wicks are properly centered and secured to ensure safe burning of finished candles. All materials, including resins, pigments, and waxes, are stored in clearly labeled, sealed containers and kept out of reach of children and pets. Any potentially hazardous materials are handled with care and disposed of in accordance with local California waste disposal guidelines. These practices allow me to safely create my work while maintaining a responsible and controlled studio environment.
