14. Describe the safety procedures you use in your craft. What, if any, safety equipment do you use? How do you store and handle any toxic or hazardous material?

I work in a well-ventilated space, wear nitrile gloves when handling solvents and toxic pigments such as cadmiums and cobalt, and use odorless mineral spirits to reduce fumes. Solvents are stored in labeled sealed containers away from children and pets, oil-soaked rags are stored in a sealed water-filled metal can to prevent spontaneous combustion, and I dispose of solvent waste at the city's hazardous waste facility rather than down the drain or in the trash.

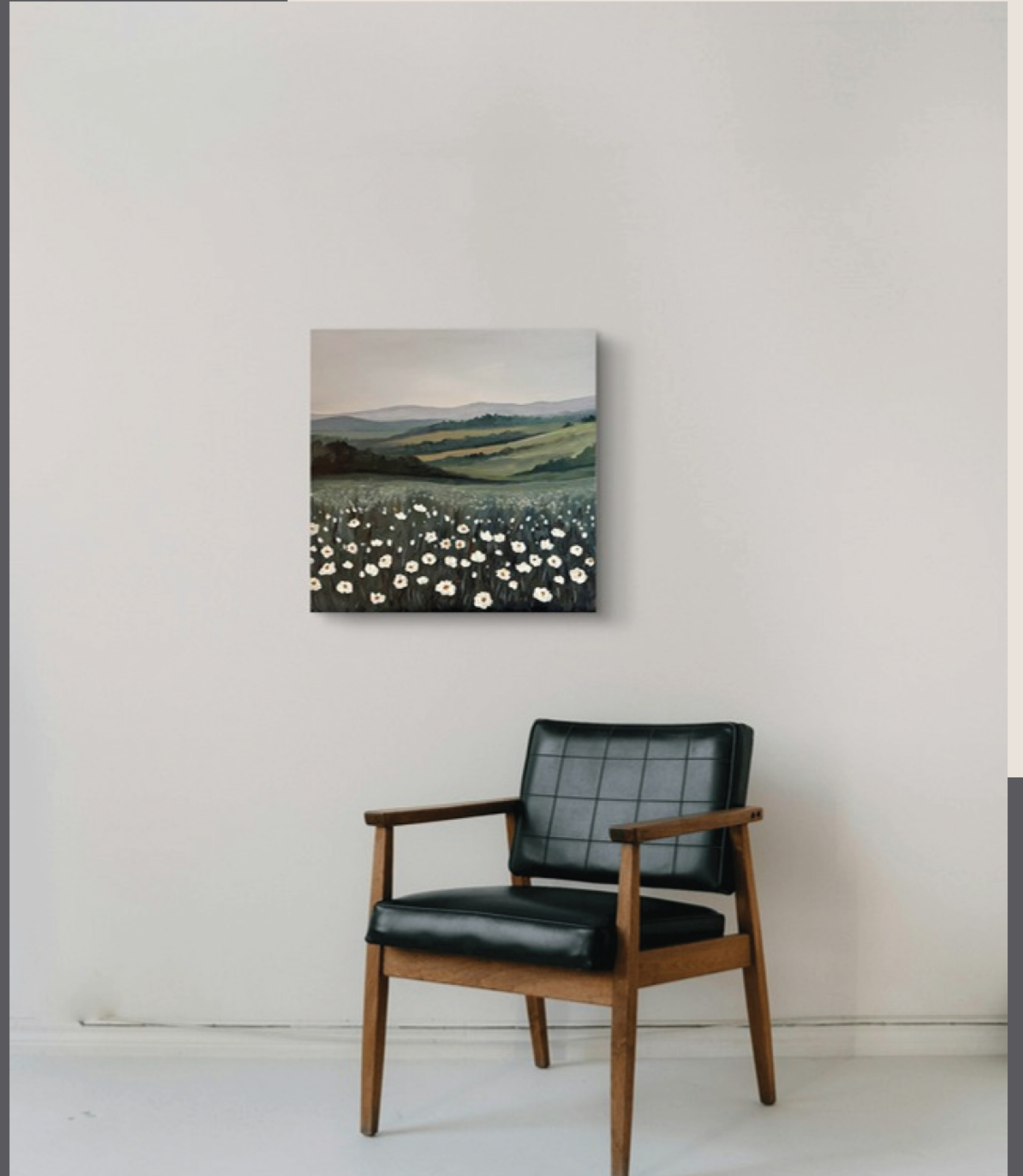
