

### **Summary of Complaints Received in August 2025**


The Department of Police Accountability received a total of **80** cases in **August 2025**, **78** SFPD complaints and **2** SFSO complaints. Compared with a total of **64** cases, **59** SFPD complaints and **5** SFSO complaint, in the same period last year, the **August 2025** case total is **21%** higher than the five-year average and is **25%** higher than the previous year.

From January through August, the DPA received a total of **646** new cases, **621** SFPD complaints and **25** SFSO complaints. Compared with the **516** cases filed during the same period in 2024, **486** SFPD complaints and **30** SFSO complaint. The August year to date case total represents an **25%** increase in new complaints over last year.



Currently, DPA has a total of 269 pending cases, 227 SFPD and 42 SFSO.

In June, DPA <u>received</u> a total of **0** referral(s) from SF Sheriff's Office and <u>referred</u> a total of **4** case(s) to SFSO.


