Resolution Commending Health Right 360 – 890 Hayes Street Site

Subject: Recognition of Community-Based Behavioral Health, Recovery, and Equity-Centered Services in the Hayes Valley and Western Addition Communities

WHEREAS, Health Right 360 operates the 890 Hayes Street site as a community-based behavioral health and substance use disorder treatment location serving individuals experiencing mental health challenges, substance use disorders, housing instability, and complex co-occurring needs;

WHEREAS, services provided at the 890 Hayes Street site may include outpatient behavioral health treatment, residential and recovery-oriented services, reentry and justice-involved support, stabilization services, case management, harm reduction programming, and coordinated linkage to housing and community supports;

WHEREAS, the 890 Hayes Street site utilizes a whole-person care model that integrates mental health, substance use treatment, physical health coordination, and social service navigation, recognizing the interconnected nature of wellness, stability, and community belonging;

WHEREAS, the site serves individuals from the Hayes Valley and Western Addition neighborhoods and throughout San Francisco who have historically faced systemic barriers to care, including communities disproportionately impacted by poverty, racial inequities, homelessness, and criminal legal system involvement;

WHEREAS, the work conducted at 890 Hayes Street aligns with the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission's priorities of advancing equity, uplifting lived experience, centering community voice, and promoting culturally responsive, trauma-informed, and recovery-oriented systems of care;

WHEREAS, staff at the 890 Hayes Street site demonstrate commitment to harm reduction principles, client self-determination, and meaningful inclusion of individuals with lived experience in program development and service delivery;

WHEREAS, the presence of accessible behavioral health and recovery services at 890 Hayes Street contributes to neighborhood stabilization, reduces avoidable hospitalizations and institutionalization, supports successful community reintegration, and strengthens public health and safety in the Hayes Valley and Western Addition corridor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission formally recognizes and commends Health Right 360's 890 Hayes Street site for its dedicated service to individuals and families in the Hayes Valley, Western Addition, and broader San Francisco communities;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission affirms the importance of equity-centered, community-driven behavioral health services and acknowledges the leadership, staff, partners, and individuals with lived experience who contribute to the success of the 890 Hayes Street site;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission expresses appreciation for the continued collaboration of Health Right 360's 890 Hayes Street site in advancing recovery, dignity, stability, and improved behavioral health outcomes for San Francisco residents.
