Subject: Commitment to Behavioral Health Equity, Recovery, and Whole-Person Care

WHEREAS, Health Right 360 is a San Francisco-based nonprofit organization dedicated to advancing health equity by providing integrated behavioral health, substance use disorder treatment, housing, reentry, and supportive services to individuals and families impacted by trauma, poverty, and systemic inequities;

WHEREAS, Health Right 360 has a long-standing history of serving some of San Francisco's most marginalized populations, including individuals experiencing housing instability, justice involvement, behavioral health challenges, and substance use disorders; through culturally responsive, trauma-informed, and evidence-based care;

WHEREAS, Health Right 360 delivers a comprehensive continuum of services that includes outpatient and residential behavioral health treatment, medication-assisted treatment, crisis stabilization, supportive housing, reentry services, and integrated primary care, addressing the complex needs of the San Francisco communities it serves;

WHEREAS, the organization's whole-person care model recognizes the interconnection between behavioral health, substance use, housing stability, physical health, and social supports, and emphasizes dignity, empowerment, and client-centered decision-making;

WHEREAS, Health Right 360's work aligns with the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission's mission to promote accessible, equitable, and high-quality behavioral health services that support recovery, self-determination, and community integration;

WHEREAS, Health Right 360 has demonstrated sustained collaboration with the City and County of San Francisco, community-based organizations, and public systems to expand access to care, reduce barriers to treatment, and improve outcomes for individuals with complex behavioral health needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission

formally recognizes and commends Health Right 360 for its commitment to advancing behavioral health equity, recovery-oriented services, and comprehensive care for San Francisco residents;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission acknowledges the essential role Health Right 360 plays in strengthening San Francisco's behavioral health continuum of care and expresses appreciation for the organization's ongoing service, partnership, and leadership;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission encourages continued collaboration with Health Right 360 to support innovation, accountability, and improved behavioral health outcomes for the communities most impacted by behavioral health disparities.
