Over-the-counter building permit issuance time	Hold at median of 1 calendar day
Completeness letters issued in 21 calendar days or less	75%
First comments issued in 30 calendar days or less	75%
Responses to revisions issued in 14 calendar days or less	75%

As of June 9, more than 900 building permit applications had been submitted through the OpenGov PermitSF Portal. 57% had received their permit, and the median days to issue the permit has held steady at 3 business days.
