

# **Slope Protection Act**

#### **Slope Protection:**


Under the previous Slope Protection Act, the shaded areas were subjected to heightened scrutiny if any part of the property featured a 25% slope.



## Landslide Zone

#### New guidelines:

Now, the heightened review is for designated landslide zones and the Mount Sutro and Edgehill areas of the City.



## **Information Sheet S-05**

- To reflect these changes, DBI Technical Services merged S-19 with S-05.
- The revised Information Sheet S-05 identifies potential triggers for heightened review of projects in landslide zones.
- It removes Structural Advisory
   Committee requirement except in
   Mount Sutro and Edgehill

## **Information Sheet S-05**

#### **New language for S-05:**

In addition to submittal of a Geotechnical Report, third party review may be required in general accordance with Administrative Bulletin AB-082:

Where any of the following work is proposed at a property that lies within, or in the immediate vicinity of, the "Earthquake-Induced Landslide" are on the state of California Department of Conservation, Division of Mines and Geology (CDMG) Seismic Hazard Zones Map for San Francisco, released November 17, 2000, or there is a history of landslides at the subject project site or in the immediate vicinity. "Immediate vicinity" shall mean any property tangent to the subject site.

## **Information Sheet S-05**

#### **New language for S-05 continued**

In addition to submittal of a Geotechnical Report, third party review may be required in landslide prone areas featuring the following:

- New buildings or structures greater than 1,000 square feet.
- Additions to existing buildings or structures creating 1,000 square feet of total aggregate new floor area, cumulative within the last three years.
- Excavation or fill of over 50 cubic yards of earth materials.
- Any other construction activity that, in the opinion of the Building Official, may have a substantial impact on the slope stability of any property.
