## **Crocker Amazon Baseball and Softball Fields Renovation Project**

### **Request for Review Form Design Concept Attachment**

Crocker Amazon Playground has operated as a neighborhood and regional park venue since the 1930's. With the growing demand for safer, reliable and accessible sports field spaces, the Department has been making improvements to many of our larger sports complexes with the goal of maximizing our limited park space and optimizing the available programming opportunities.

The proposed project includes the renovation of five existing baseball/softball fields and associated park amenities supporting the fields. The project envisions the realignment of the existing fields so that the space can accommodate six renovated baseball/softball fields. Five of the fields would be improved using synthetic turf and one field would remain grass. All fields would host new fencing, dugouts, spectator seating and scoreboards. The five synthetic fields would also include night lighting for evening play. The existing parking lot would be resurfaced and expanded from 81 to 141 stalls. The overall park design includes a new dog park play area (DPA), renovation of the existing DPA, installation of a free-standing restroom building, a three tunnel batting cage structure, an outdoor public gathering space, new pathways, new exercise equipment and standard park furniture (fountains, tables, trash cans) The project would also include irrigation and planting throughout project area.
