## **Ensuring LBE Subcontractors**Are Informed

All subs should know they are on a project ...but...

- Subs provide quotes to bidders but it's not always clear if/when awards are made
- With many bids in motion, subs are not always sure of correct contract name/number
- Learning award info earlier would help subs plan
- Clear and timely communication that fosters engagement

## CMD Delivers: Notice to LBEs They Are On the Job

How do CMD's notices help the project?

- For Primes
  - Transparency and better communication leads to fewer disputes and stronger relationships
- For Subs
  - Can plan staffing, scheduling, finances
  - Can proactively engage with Primes and CMD
- For City Departments
  - Supports oversight of LBE Program requirements
  - Reduced risk of disputes and substitutions
  - Supports City's commitment to transparency and fair participation

# Rules & Regs Alignment with Chapter 14B Clean-Up

#### File 250508 passed.

Minimum Competitive Amount and Threshold Amount for contracting to reflect recent consumer price index increases. "Delegated Purchasing Amount" as a defined term added (and replaces incorrect, hardcoded numbers). **No Substantive Policy Changes.** 

#### **Next step:**

Align Rules and Regulations with recent Chapter 14 Clean-Up.

Replace static dollar amount with term "Delegated Purchasing Amount."



### Updates for clarity Program remains unchanged

- Updates to make it unmistakably clear that some information is for education and tracking only
- Changes you may see
  - LBE subcontracting Requirement memo
  - Form 5 and portion of Form 2A
  - Language in some RFPs

### **Legislation UPDATE**

File <u>250192</u>

Open for Business.

**Approved on First Reading:** 

Legislation intended to make it easier and cheaper for small businesses, nonprofits, and city departments to do work with the City by simplifying contract rules, especially for smaller contracts under \$230,000.

No change to 14B.

**Prop E (2024):** 

Created the <u>Commission Streamlining Task</u>
<u>Force</u>. Task Force will make
recommendations on which commissions
should be modified, combined, or eliminated
to improve administration of City government.


