Subject: Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing's Administrative Code Ch 21B.3

Quarterly Report

On February 11, 2025, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 010-25, codified in Chapter 21B of the Administrative Code, to suspend and delegate certain approvals for Contracts and Leases necessary to accelerate the City's response to homelessness, drug overdoses and substance use disorders, mental health needs, integrated health needs, and public safety hiring (the "Core Initiatives Ordinance"). The Ordinance took effect on March 14, 2025, and included the requirement for designated departments to report quarterly on contracts and leases executed under Administrative Code Section 21B.3.

The Core Initiatives Ordinance maintained the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing's (HSH's) existing streamlined contracting authority under Administrative Code 21B (Ordinance No. 038-24), that will expire on May 5, 2029. Under this authority, the Department has continued to enter and amend agreements without adhering to provisions regarding competitive bidding related to projects addressing homelessness. Required reporting under Ordinance No. 038-24 has been incorporated into this quarterly report.

This report fulfills HSH's quarterly reporting obligations under Administrative Code 21B for the third and fourth quarters of FY2024-25¹. The report includes all contracts, grant agreements and leases executed by HSH under Chapter 21B during the reporting period.

In Q3 and Q4 of FY2024-25, HSH entered into 4 contracts, 31 grant agreements and 1 lease agreement under Chapter 21B. These agreements supported both new and existing projects addressing homelessness across the following service areas:

- Homelessness Prevention (3)
- Housing Problem Solving (1)
- Shelter (8)
- Housing (24)
