RE: Information for The Salvation Army's Marina Inn Recovery Housing to be established at 3110 Octavia Street.

The purpose of this memo is to provide a summary and supporting documentation pertaining to the Health Commission hearing scheduled for June 2, 2025 regarding a new DPH project, and to document the Department's compliance with Chapter 79 of San Francisco's Administrative Code and DPH's own Good Neighbor Policy. This new project, which is a partnership between DPH and The Salvation Army, was announced by Mayor Lurie on April 30, 2025.

On June 2, 1998, the voters of San Francisco adopted Proposition I, known as the "Citizens' Right-to-Know Act of 1998". This allows for citizens to know about proposed city government projects paid for with taxpayers' dollars; it establishes a formal noticing requirement to inform interested citizens of their right to bring their concerns to the attention of the City departments and agencies involved in the project before a City Project is considered for approval; and it brings opportunity for project sponsors to make sure City Projects meet the needs of the neighborhoods in which the projects are to be located.

Proposition I was codified as [Chapter 79](#) of the City's Administrative Code, which details the minimum noticing requirements prior to the approval of a City Project by a city officer, department, board or commission. [Chapter 79A](#), adopted in 2012, expanded upon these noticing requirements by extending the minimum notice period from 15 days to 30 days. To meet the intent of Chapter 79 and Chapter 79A, the Department of Public Health adopted the DPH Good Neighbor Policy. The purpose of this policy is to educate DPH staff and DPH project owners of department procedures necessary to be in compliance with Chapter 79 and Chapter 79A.

The Health Commission hearing on June 2, 2025 is the required hearing to allow interested residents and the public at large to bring concerns or comments pertaining to the establishment of The Salvation Army's Marina Inn Recovery Housing at 3110 Octavia Street. This hearing follows an initial community meeting that DPH requires per the DPH Good Neighbor Policy, and a secondary meeting scheduled by DPH to accommodate more feedback from the community.

In overview, DPH completed its signage postings on April 25, 2025 for the required community meeting and for the Health Commission hearing on June 2, 2025. A total of 91 individuals attended the initial meeting. A secondary meeting was held on May 20, 2025 that had 93 people

in attendance. For more information about the required community meeting, other Good Neighbor Policy requirements, and additional community outreach efforts, please see the Attachments. Additionally, please note that DPH and The Salvation Army representatives will also present an overview of the project, providing additional information to describe the project's goals and objectives during the June 2, 2025 meeting.

In compliance with Chapter 79 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, (put into effect July 9, 1998 upon the passage by voters of Proposition I “Citizens Right to Know” Act of 1998), and the Department of Public Health’s (DPH) “Good Neighbor Policy”, established in response to Chapter 79, the purpose of this meeting is for the DPH Health Commission to allow interested persons and the public-at-large the opportunity to bring up their concerns prior to the final funding and approval of the project.

Chapter 79 of the San Francisco Admin. Code identifies the specific types of City projects that are subject to Chapter 79, along with required notification procedures. The DPH “Good Neighbor Policy” captures these requirements, while setting forth DPH’s intent to work collaboratively with neighbors to allay fears regarding the siting of new programs in neighborhoods. The following summary describes DPH’s Good Neighbor Policy process for the following project:

Purpose of Program:	<p>The Marina Inn Recovery Housing is a two-year recovery housing facility designed to support long-term health, stability, and independence for San Franciscans in recovery. The program offers 24 months of drug-free post-treatment recovery housing for adults who have completed substance use disorder treatment.</p> <p>This program aims to empower participants to achieve lasting recovery by providing a supportive environment that prioritizes stability, financial independence, and personal growth, setting them on a path toward lifelong success and self-sufficiency.</p>

DPH Good Neighbor Policy Requirements Implementation:

Notice Requirements

Public notice of a proposed new City project must be posted at least 30 days prior to the date at which a new City project will be considered for approval. In lieu of signposting requirements, notices may be mailed to property owners within 300 feet of the lot line of the property.

DPH Public Notification: Two signs were posted on Friday, April 25, 2025, to announce (1) the Health Commission Meeting to be held on June 2, 2025, and (2) the required initial community meeting to be held on Tuesday, May 6, 2025. The purpose of the latter meeting held to obtain community feedback in compliance with DPH’s Good Neighbor Policy. As DPH posted the required notification signage for the meetings, a separate mailing of the notice was not required. Nonetheless, DPH staff conducted outreach by walking to 35 businesses within 300 feet of 3110 Octavia Street during the dates of April 28 to 30, 2025. Flyers were also mailed to 626 surrounding residents and property owners on May 25, 2025. Community Meetings

The DPH Good Neighbor Policy establishes a required community meeting prior to the Health Commission meeting to be held with the contractor involved to (a) give information to interested neighbors and the public-at-large about the project, and to (b) receive input from the public about any concerns regarding the project. Additionally, the Good Neighbor Policy speaks to DPH's commitment to ongoing collaborative work with its neighbors.

First Meeting

The first meeting was held at 1974 Union Street on May 6, 2025, from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. The meeting was attended by the DPH Business Office of Contract Compliance (BOCC) Director Jerna Reyes and BOCC Contract Compliance Managers Craig Wenzl, Denise Williams, and William Gramlich. Department of Public Health Director Daniel Tsai, Dr. Christy Soran of DPH Behavioral Health Services Substance Use Services, Steve Adami of The Salvation Army, and District 2 Supervisor Stephen Sherrill were also in attendance and served as the panel for the meeting. Based on the sign-in sheets (See [Attachment 6](#)), there were 91 attendees including DPH, The Salvation Army staff and representatives, and the public.

The meeting began with welcome remarks from Supervisor Sherrill who introduced Daniel Tsai. Director Tsai started by giving a brief background of himself and stressed the need for a direct, urgent approach to address the homeless and substance use crisis in the streets by breaking the cycle of substance use and alleviating bottlenecks and client cycling within a continuum of care. He noted the Mayor's "breaking the cycle" approach by focusing on the expansion of sober living environments to address the growing demand for post-treatment stability and recovery housing, and how this approach supports clients returning to the community who are without adequate support. This approach, in partnership with The Salvation Army, offers programming for people who have successfully completed treatment to have a safe place to stay as they integrate into the community.

Steve Adami spoke next about The Salvation Army and The Way Out's continuum of care. He introduced the Marina Inn Recovery Housing programming to include 24/7 staffing, onsite case management and supportive services, drug testing, and required recovery meetings and employment. No guests or visitors are allowed in the facility. The Marina Inn will be 100% alcohol and drug-free, staffed with people trained in de-escalation, harm reduction, and overdose response. He introduced his and his colleagues' roles in the programming of the Marina Inn Recovery Housing. He also discussed adherence to DPH's Good Neighbor Policy with coordination with SFPD, commitment to regular communication with the community, designated neighborhood liaisons, and having community call lines.

DPH's Dr. Christy Soran spoke about the role of DPH and the importance of abstinence-based, residential programs such as the Marina Inn Recovery Housing in supporting the City's overall vision of breaking the cycle of substance use.

The next portion of the meeting was spent responding to questions and obtaining feedback from the community. The panelists were Director Tsai, Dr. Soran, and Steve Adami. Please see

Attachment 7 for a summary of the meeting topics and themes. Notes were taken by BOCC staff who were present during the meeting. The meeting was wrapped up after the panel portion by Director Tsai by giving information for the second meeting on May 20 at Moscone Rec Center as well as the June 2 presentation at the Health Commission meeting.

Second Meeting

The second meeting was held at 1800 Chestnut Street on May 20, 2025, from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. It was attended by BOCC Contract Compliance Managers Denise Williams and William Gramlich. Department of Public Health Director Daniel Tsai, San Francisco Chief of Health and Human Services Kunal Modi, District 2 Supervisor Stephen Sherrill, Steve Adami of The Salvation Army, and SFPD Northern Station Captain Newbeck, were also in attendance and served as the panel for the meeting. Based on the sign-in sheets (See Attachment 6), 93 individuals were in attendance including DPH and The Salvation Army staff and representatives, and the public.

The meeting began with welcome remarks from Supervisor Sherrill who also informed the attendees that the priority of the second meeting was to ensure that the community's questions were answered. He spoke about a promise of accountability from the new San Francisco administration, gave information for the Health Commission hearing on June 2, and thanked the community for standing up for itself and its members. Kunal Modi of the Mayor's Office spoke next about wanting to help the City recover, and address the public safety and street crisis conditions and he explained that his role in the meeting was to listen to feedback and ensure that the questions from the community were answered. He spoke about the City's administration being new and focused on listening to the community and transparency.

Director Tsai acknowledged the community's experience with people actively using drugs in the neighborhood shelter-in-place (SIP) settings during COVID, and how one of the issues that SF faces today is a lack of safe, stable recovery housing options where individuals who have successfully completed a drug treatment program can be re-integrated back into the community. He spoke about the Marina Inn Recovery Housing not being a treatment program, such as ones being opened across the City; that the project is a step-down, sober living environment where participants will be employed and getting coached for financial independence and other life skills. He then spoke about the City and DPH not having utilized enough recovery-oriented, sober-living programs such as the ones that The Salvation Army operates across the City. He expressed his commitment, transparency, and honesty on what the community asks, though there may be disagreements between him and the audience.

Steve Adami spoke next, starting with his background of being a City employee for 10 years, and fighting against City funding for drug tolerant and drug permissive housing, fighting against open air drug markets in the City, and having no association with anything that has to do with drug use and low-barrier programs. He provided program information for the Marina Inn Recovery Housing including being a highly structured program for people who have already been in treatment and been stable for a minimum of six months. In addition, he said there would be no smoking and

loitering in the program, employment and outside meetings would be required, onsite coaches would be available. He also stated that the program aims to have people achieve independence, be less dependent on government, exit the program to their own housing, and rejoin families. He acknowledged the concerns that the community has brought up with him and how he agrees with them, and that he was against SIP hotels as well. He emphasized the focus of The Salvation Army to help people regain their lives through accountability, without which people often do not change. He assured the audience that he would not let the program destroy the neighborhood and gave his phone number so he can be contacted directly.

The remainder of the meeting was spent responding to questions and obtaining feedback from the community. The panelists were Kunal Modi, Director Tsai, Steve Adami, and Steven Betts. Please see [Attachment 7](#) for a summary of the meeting topics and themes. Notes were taken by BOCC and DPH staff who were present during the meeting. The meeting was wrapped up after the panel portion and the panelists stayed after the meeting to respond to additional questions.

SUMMARY OF COMMUNITY COMMENTS FROM THE MARINA INN
COMMUNITY MEETINGS

Notes taken during the May 6, 2025 community meeting are grouped into themes below:

1. Success of the Program

The community questioned why the program is being placed in a drug-dealing area of the neighborhood, across from a cannabis dispensary, and what will be done to keep the Marina Inn Recovery Housing residents apart from the drug dealers. Comments were also made on uncertainty about the success of the program regarding where the Marina Inn Recovery Housing residents will get jobs, with the program being placed in an expensive city. Examples of statistical successes of the same type of program were requested. Additionally, the community had questions about program plans if a Marina Inn Recovery Housing resident relapses.

The meeting panel stated that the proposed project is for people who have already successfully completed treatment and that the program is a drug-free, sober environment where the residents can be in a safer area for up to two years. Participants will have a buddy system in place when they leave the residence. The panel noted that relapses do not often occur in the level of programming that the Marina Inn Recovery Housing will have; however, The Salvation Army will work with other programs to take responsibility for a resident if one relapses, including having a plan for where the resident can go. There will be sites that people who have relapsed can be triaged to, so that they will not just be out on the streets after relapsing. The program will be staffed by trained and experienced people. A recent shift in San Francisco was mentioned regarding strong community support for sober-living programs such as the Marina Inn Recovery Housing was mentioned. Supervisor Sherrill informed the attendees that a formerly planned cannabis dispensary is no longer interested in opening across the street from the location of the program. Steve Adami said that there is a 76% success rate at The Salvation Army's similar program in the Mission with success including stability in recovery, employment, and housing upon exit from the program. He added that this is a pivotal moment in San Francisco to be talking about taking people off drugs and not just off the streets.

2. Why this neighborhood?

There was public comment about why this location was chosen, how the residents worked hard to buy a home in a safe neighborhood, and concerns about the program presenting “a great number of strangers” in and out of the neighborhood.

Director Tsai acknowledged the community’s concerns and reiterated that the proposed project is for people who have already successfully completed treatment and that the program is a drug-free, sober environment. He discussed the difficulty of looking for a site for a safe, sober living program.

3. Why The Salvation Army?

Concern about and lack of trust in The Salvation Army was commented on, with a sexual battery case in Ohio specifically brought up as an example, and mention of other cases in other states.

Steve Adami clarified that Marina Inn Recovery Housing is not the same type of program as the one in Ohio which is a low-barrier program as opposed to the Marina Inn’s abstinence-based structure and programming. The community member who asked the question was referred to The Salvation Army’s PR staff for more information about the Denver case.

4. Safety/Security

There were concerns about safety for the residents and businesses concerning crime that community members had been experiencing recently, as well as the need for more police presence. One community member brought up the experience of waiting for 1 hour for the police to show up after they called for help.

Steve Adami spoke about the Marina Inn planning to be a good neighbor who will add value to the community and not take away from it, and how the program model is “the best of the best”. He also spoke about this type of program supporting people in staying safe and out of harm’s way. He highlighted the programmatic response for the people who are living in the program and stressed that the Marina Inn is a highly structured residential program where participants will be working, earning income, and saving money.

5. Support for the Marina Inn

There were community comments in support of the drug-free and abstinence-based programming at the Marina Inn Recovery Housing program as a transition from treatment for people who are clean and sober. It was highlighted that this is a program for people who have already been in treatment for 6 months and want to stay in a sober environment. Confidence about the program being successful in other places was also expressed.

6. Other Questions:

Q: Is the Marina Inn for women only?

A: (Steve Adami) The program is open to men and women, with one floor dedicated to women.

Q: What are the plans for managing parking?

A: (Steve Adami) Fewer than 5% of residents in the Mission residence have cars.

Q: What is DPH's involvement in the project?

A: (Director Tsai) The contract is with The Salvation Army and the agency is responsible for what is in the contract, with the agency being accountable to DPH.

Q: What is the work policy for people living in the Marina Inn Recovery Housing?

A: (Steve Adami) Residents will be looking for a variety of jobs, and those residents who are disabled will be required to do volunteer work. The Salvation Army also has a catering program that places people in partnered restaurants. People in a program adjust to having work schedules.

Q: How far is the outreach going to be? 300 feet is not enough.

A: (Director Tsai) Steve said that he will engage with anybody in the community who wants to engage. He also reminded the audience that Steve gave his phone number out for direct communication.

Notes taken during the May 20, 2025 community meeting are grouped into themes below:

1. Success of the Program

There were concerns regarding the success and effectiveness of the program, with doubts expressed that participants who relapse would willingly return to treatment.

Steve Adami said that there is an 80% success rate based on participants staying sober, employed, and financially independent at a similar program. Participants will engage in support groups like AA, NA, and religious organizations to foster long-term recovery. The Marina Inn aims to equip participants with adaptive coping strategies, pro-social behavior, and life skills for re-integration into society. Participants who relapse are re-introduced to earlier levels of care instead of being sent back to the streets.

2. Why this neighborhood?

There were questions regarding City planning and zoning issues. Concerns were raised about the facility's proximity to schools, playgrounds, and residential areas. There was fear that the program would negatively affect the neighborhood's stability, particularly in a child-friendly area. Residents proposed alternative locations away from residential areas such as commercial zones. Then concerns were brought up as well about how the program will impact the commercial zone on Chestnut Street that is currently improved after 10 years. There were related concerns about neighborhood capacity as the location of the program, suggesting that other areas of the city with existing support systems would be better.

Steve Adami discussed how one of the goals of the program is to minimize neighborhood impact by maintaining the residents' structure for alcohol- and drug-free living including having curfews. Participants will work outside the facility during the day and then have activities and continued participation in recovery meetings in the evenings. There will also be case management and resident accountability.

3. Public Safety/Security

The neighborhood has experienced drug-related incidents, vandalism, and break-ins and there were concerns that the program would bring increased crime, loitering, and reduced property values from individuals entering the program who might have violent or offender criminal histories. There was a comment that the program looks like an alternative sentence program for participants with criminal records and if there was a vetting process for such participants.

Concerns that individuals who relapse may remain in or return to the neighborhood and pose safety risks were also raised. Safety concerns about the program being near playgrounds and schools, particularly for families with young children was brought up. And there were questions about the ability of the local police who have limited resources to adequately respond to issues.

Steve Adami explained that no 290 sex offenders or people with arson-related charges will be accepted to the program. Other convictions will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Everyone will go through a third-party background check upon enrollment. Most of the participants will be coming from The Salvation Army's treatment program at SoMa. They will be assessed to determine their appropriateness for the Marina Inn Recovery Housing or to receive services at another program. Director Tsai also clarified that the Marina Inn Recovery Housing is not a diversion program.

Kunal Modi also emphasized that the Mayor's number one priority is public safety and street conditions, and that City leadership will not open any site that they believe will negatively impact public safety or street conditions. The City will be mindful of the economic implications of a holistic approach. Law enforcement present at the meeting acknowledged staffing limitations but committed to responding to safety concerns and maintaining security. Steven Betts guaranteed that the police will come if they are called to do so.

4. Facility Structural Safety

There were also concerns regarding the facility's capacity to accommodate the number of participants without straining the building and surrounding infrastructure. There were concerns regarding the landlord because of their history of owning motels.

Director Tsai said that City Planning was involved, acknowledged the feedback, and committed to a walkthrough of the facility, reviewing the square footage and capacity of the facility, and adjusting the program census if that is appropriate.

5. Distrust in City Leadership and DPH

Lack of trust in the City leadership's ability to manage the program effectively was brought up with reference to mismanagement of SIP hotels in the neighborhood in the past. There were comments about mishandling communication about the contract being made and the program being established in the neighborhood. The community requested better communication in the future, a mayoral directive or policy to redirect funds to SFPD for dealing with substance use close to playgrounds and schools, and "checks and balances" prior to opening another facility within a certain radius.

Kunal Modi guaranteed that the City's leadership is focused on things that they think are going to be helpful, or on a different type of model than what was done in the past. He added that the City is also in the process of reviewing existing programs to make determinations on how these programs need to change, evolve, or be closed. He acknowledged and apologized for having communicated the Marina Inn Recovery Housing project poorly, responded that he had learned from this, and said that the City owes the community a public safety plan. He also said that there will be no other programs in the Marina.

6. Accountability and Program Monitoring

There was a request for the evaluation criteria on the RFP; what the leading and lagging indicators are and the key performance indicators that this program is working for both the individual and the neighborhood. The community requested clarity regarding program budgets, contracts, and financial oversight. There were questions of how the program's success will be measured and how failures will be managed. Safety plans and clear accountability measures were also requested.

Director Tsai said that there was no RFP for the contract with The Salvation Army because that would have taken longer, which would have delayed getting more of the right types of treatment, housing, and recovery options for the City, as well as program results. He added that The Salvation Army will be held accountable for both clinical and community impacts. He committed to sharing contracts, program model and structure, and oversight mechanisms, as well as creating measurable outcomes for the program.

7. Support for the Marina Inn Recovery Housing

There were comments of support from the community based on personal or professional experiences with addiction and rehabilitation. The need for addressing addiction and homelessness with recovery-based solutions was highlighted.

Note: 36 emails were received or forwarded to DPH between April 27 to May 28, 2025. 21

messages were in opposition to the Marina Inn, and 14 were supportive.
