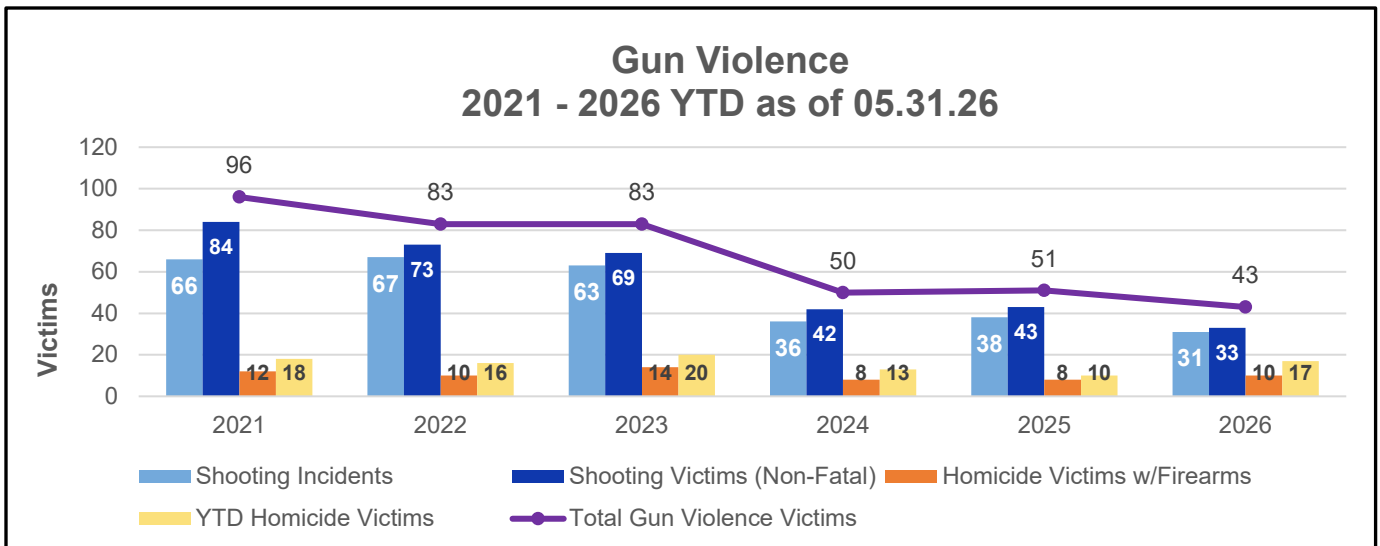
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 16% compared to 2025

- There were no shooting incidents causing injuries to any victims the week ending 05.31.26
 - There is a total of 39 fatal/non-fatal shooting incidents resulting in 43 victims; 10 homicides, 33 non-fatal

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 70% compared to 2025

- **There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 05.31.26**
 - There are 17 homicides YTD with 10 resulting from a firearm.
 - There was 1 homicide in May 2026
 - **Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 106%**

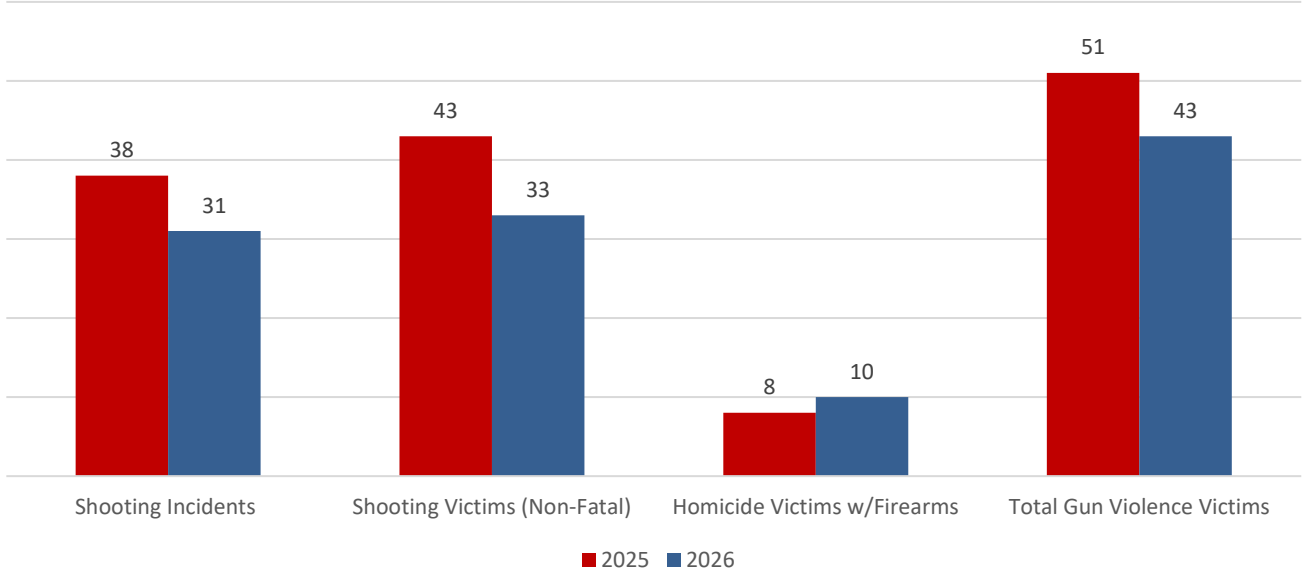

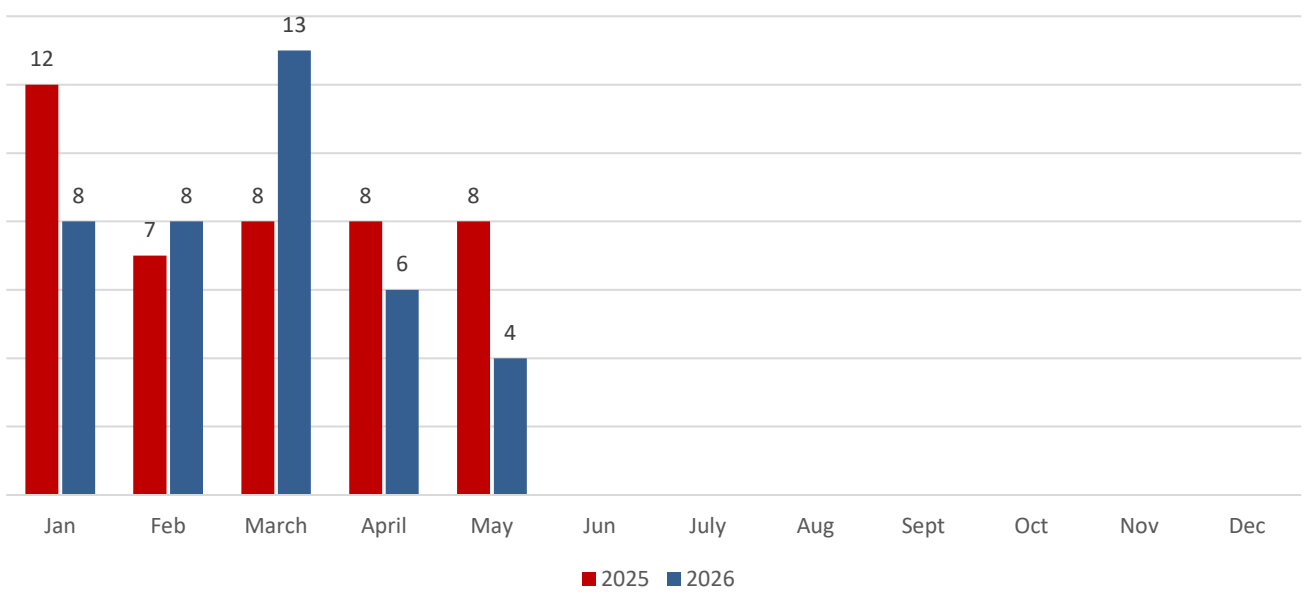

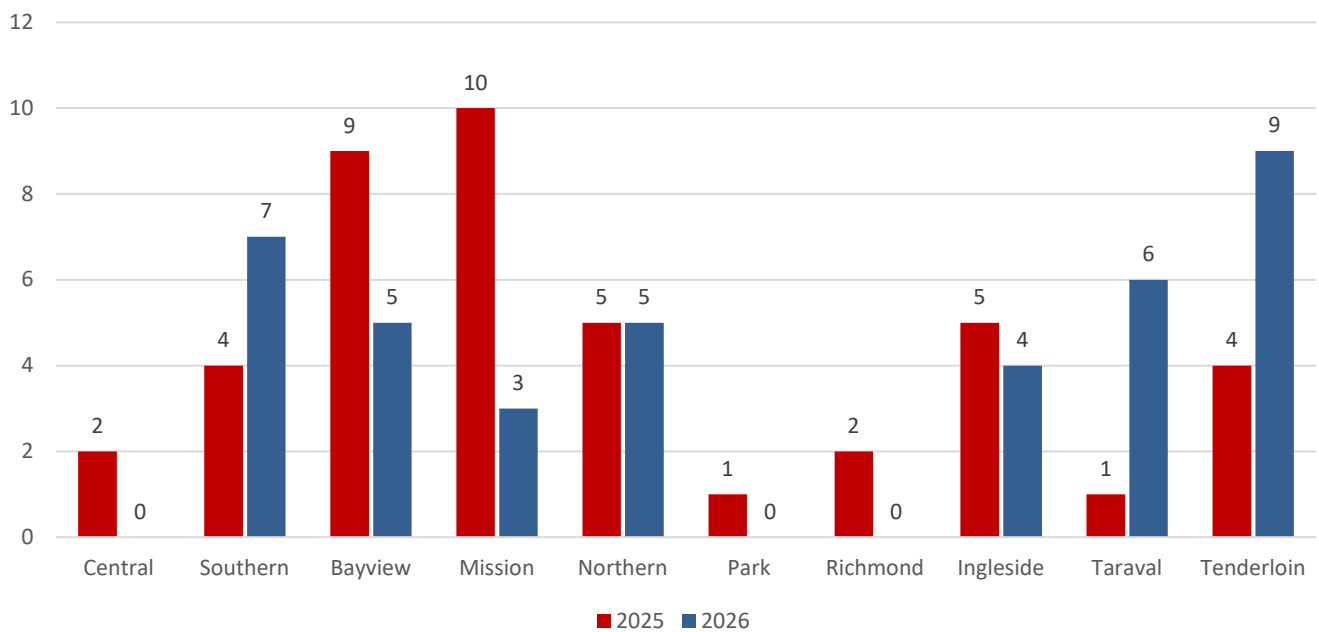
Gun Violence 2025 vs 2026 YTD



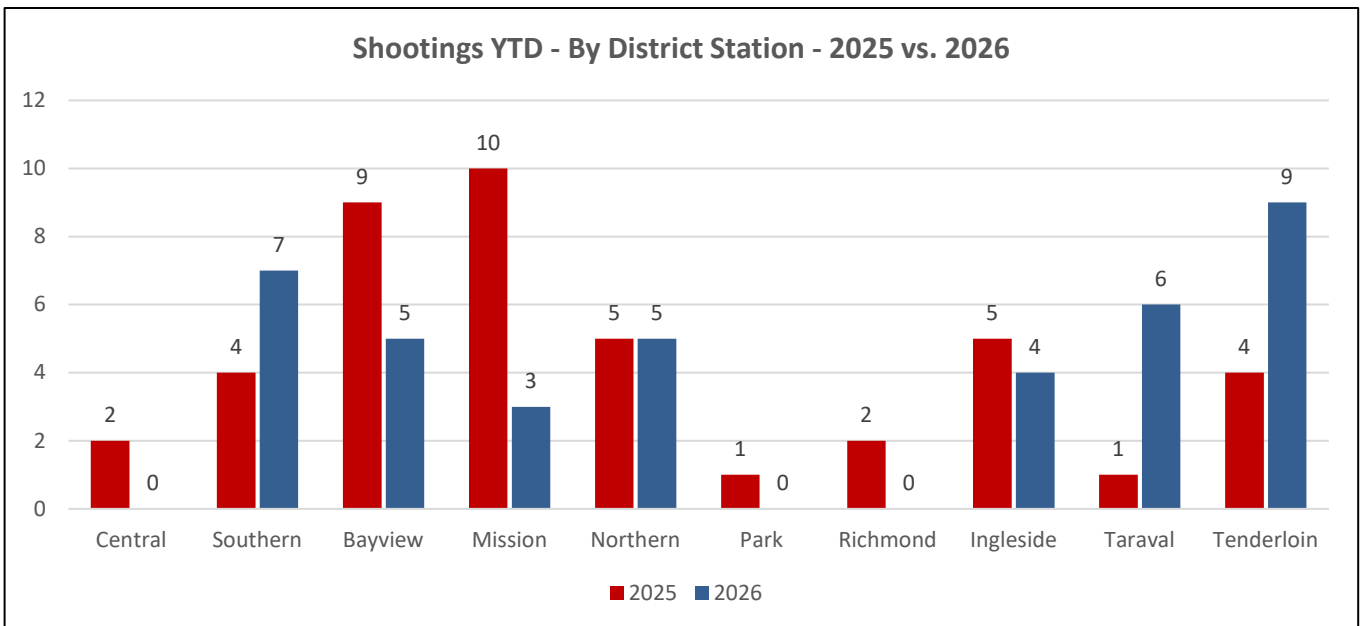
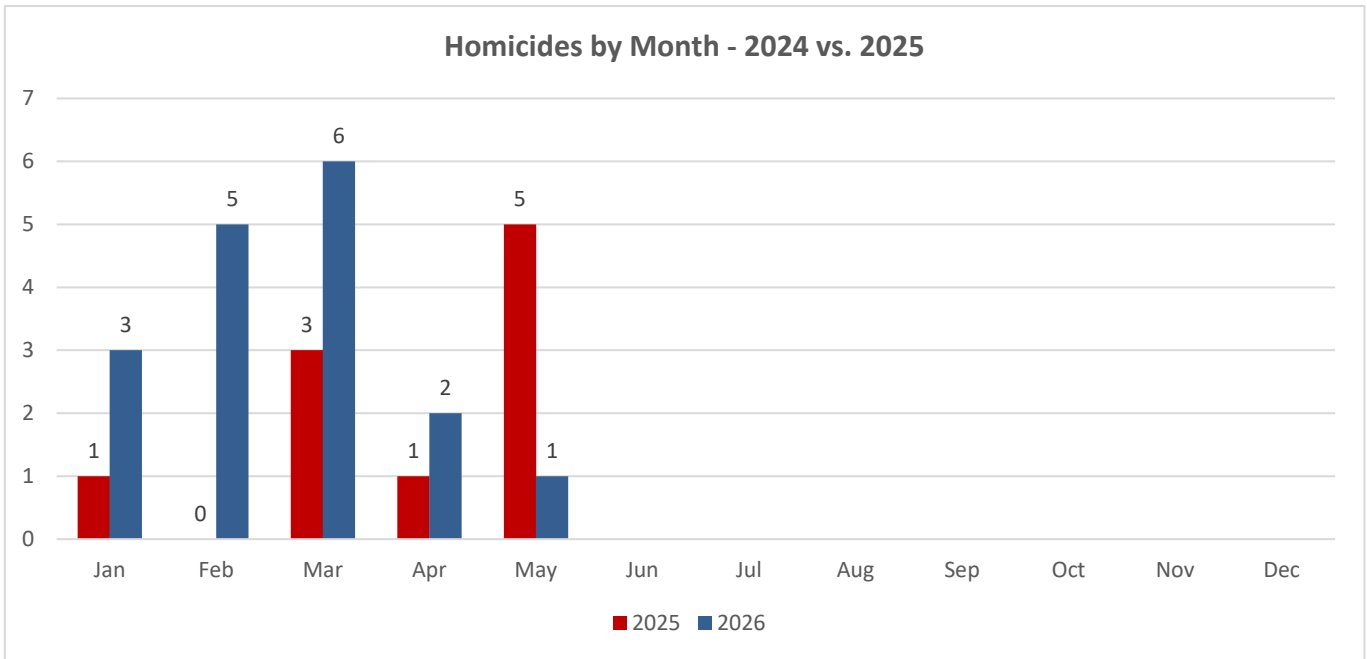
Shootings YTD - By Month - 2025 vs. 2026
