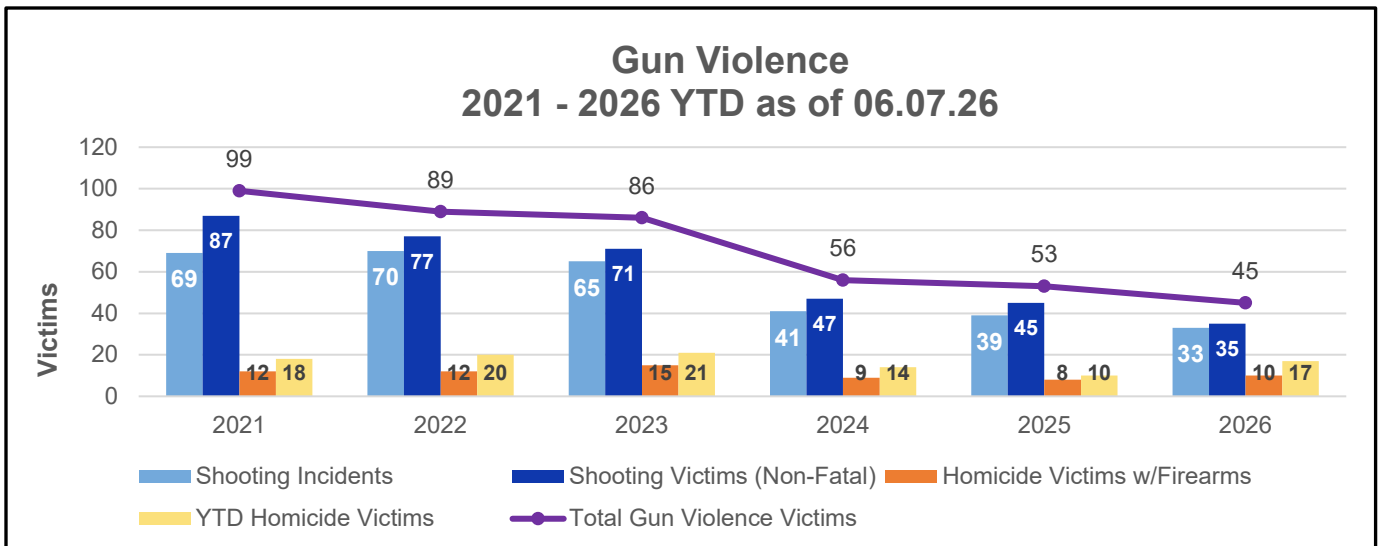
**GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE**

**GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 15% compared to 2025**

- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims the week ending 06.07.26
  - There is a total of 41 fatal/non-fatal shooting incidents resulting in 45 victims; 10 homicides, 35 non-fatal

**TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 70% compared to 2025**

- **There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 06.07.26**
  - There are 17 homicides YTD with 10 resulting from a firearm.
  - There are no homicides in June 2026
  - **Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 112%**

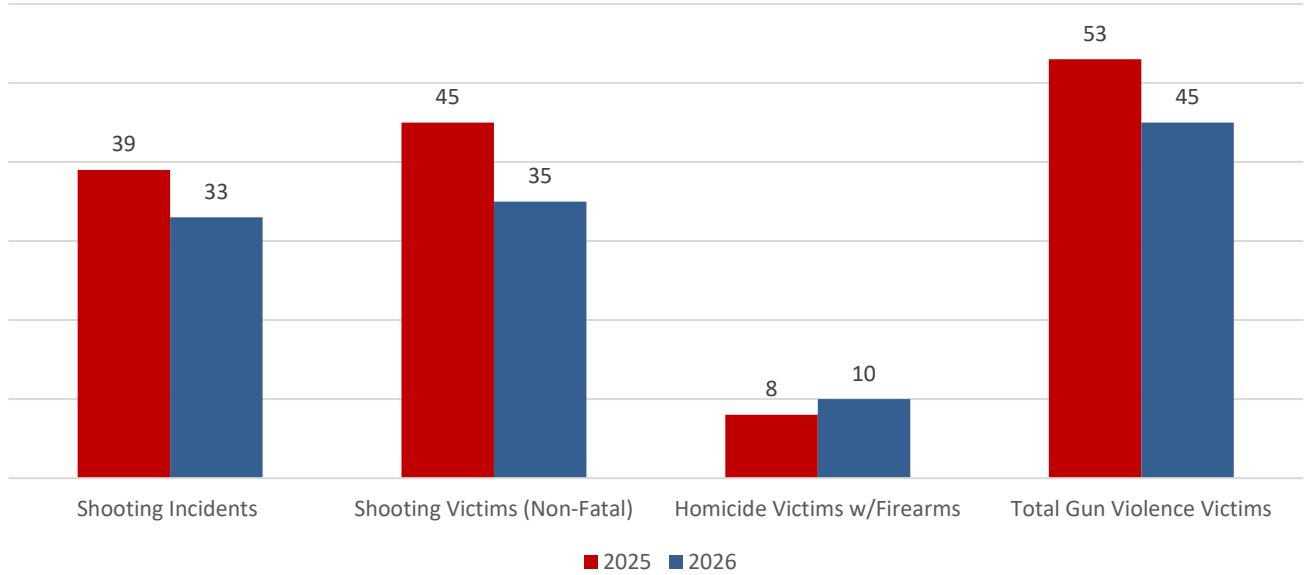

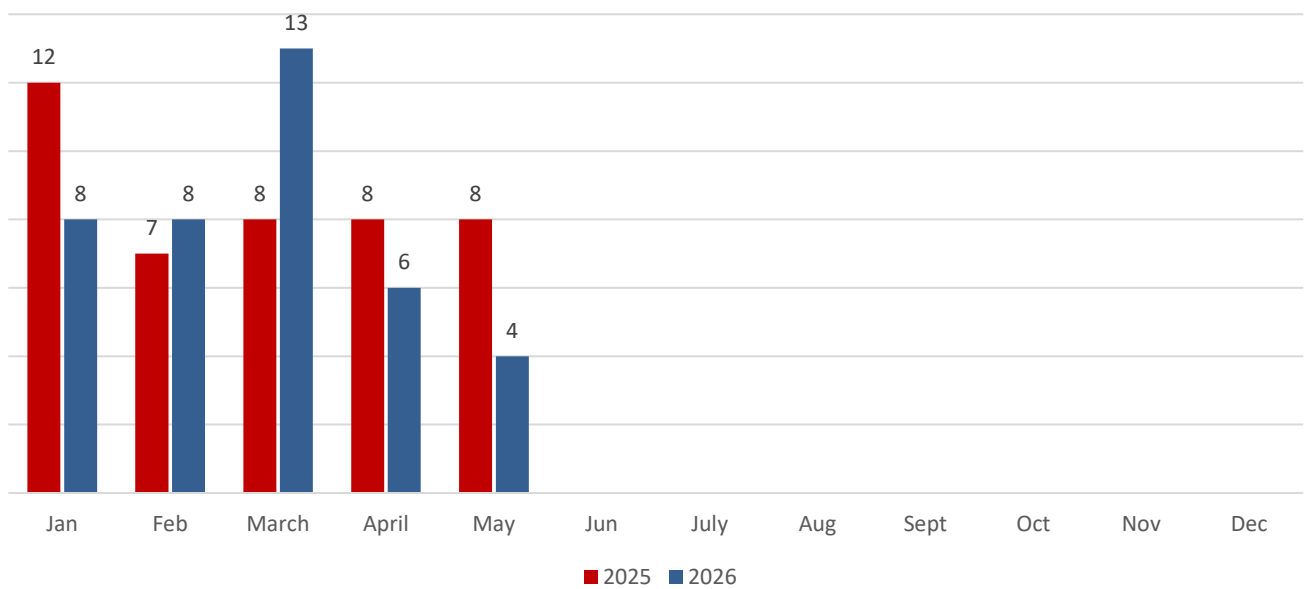

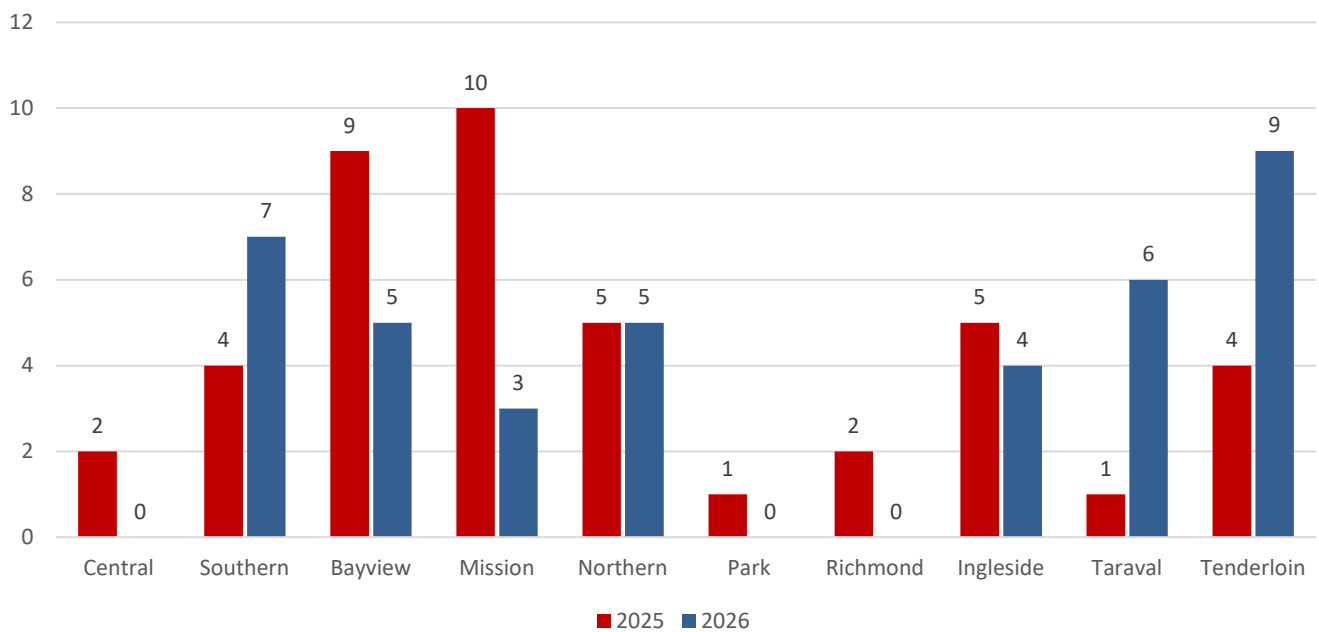
### Gun Violence 2025 vs 2026 YTD



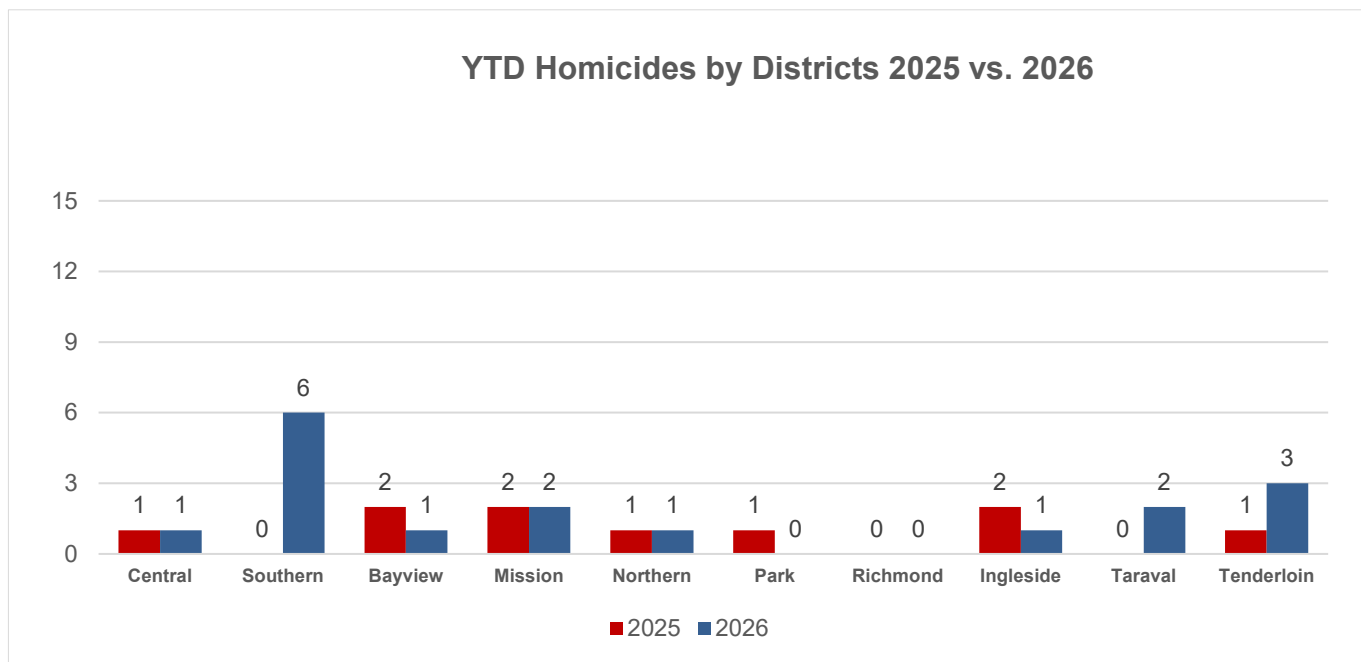
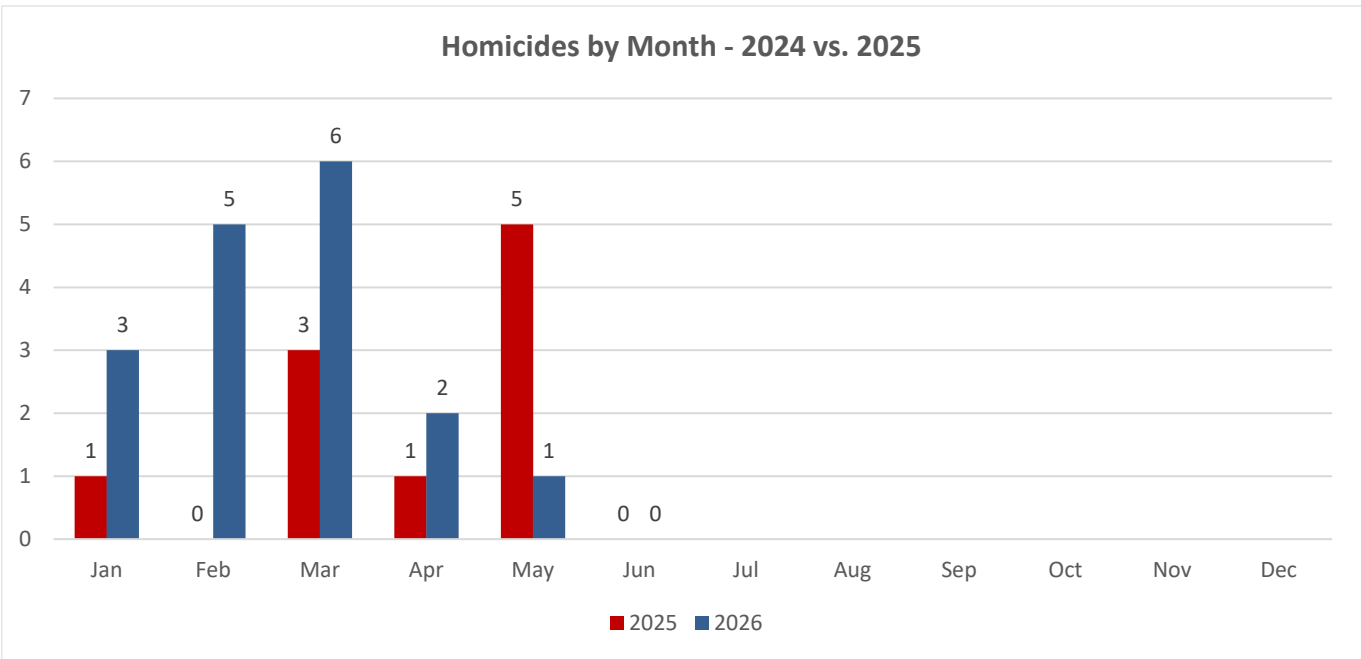
### Shootings YTD - By Month - 2025 vs. 2026
