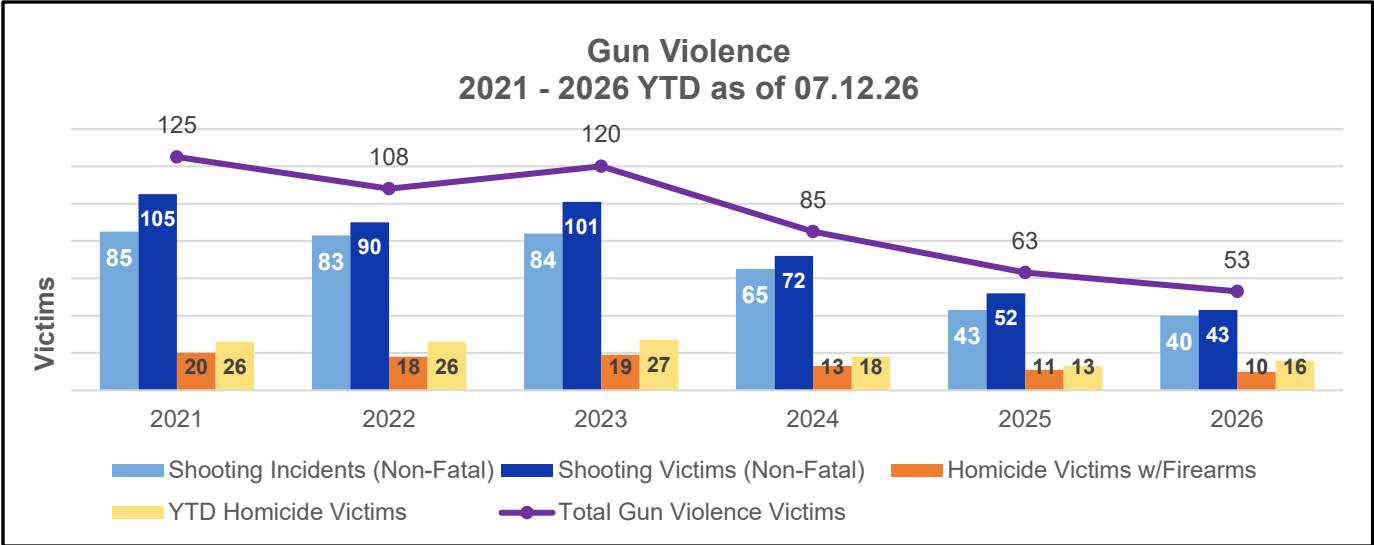
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

**GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 16% compared to 2025**

- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims the week ending 07.12.26
  - There is a total of 47 fatal/non-fatal shooting incidents resulting in 53 victims; 10 homicides, 43 non-fatal

**TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 23% compared to 2025**

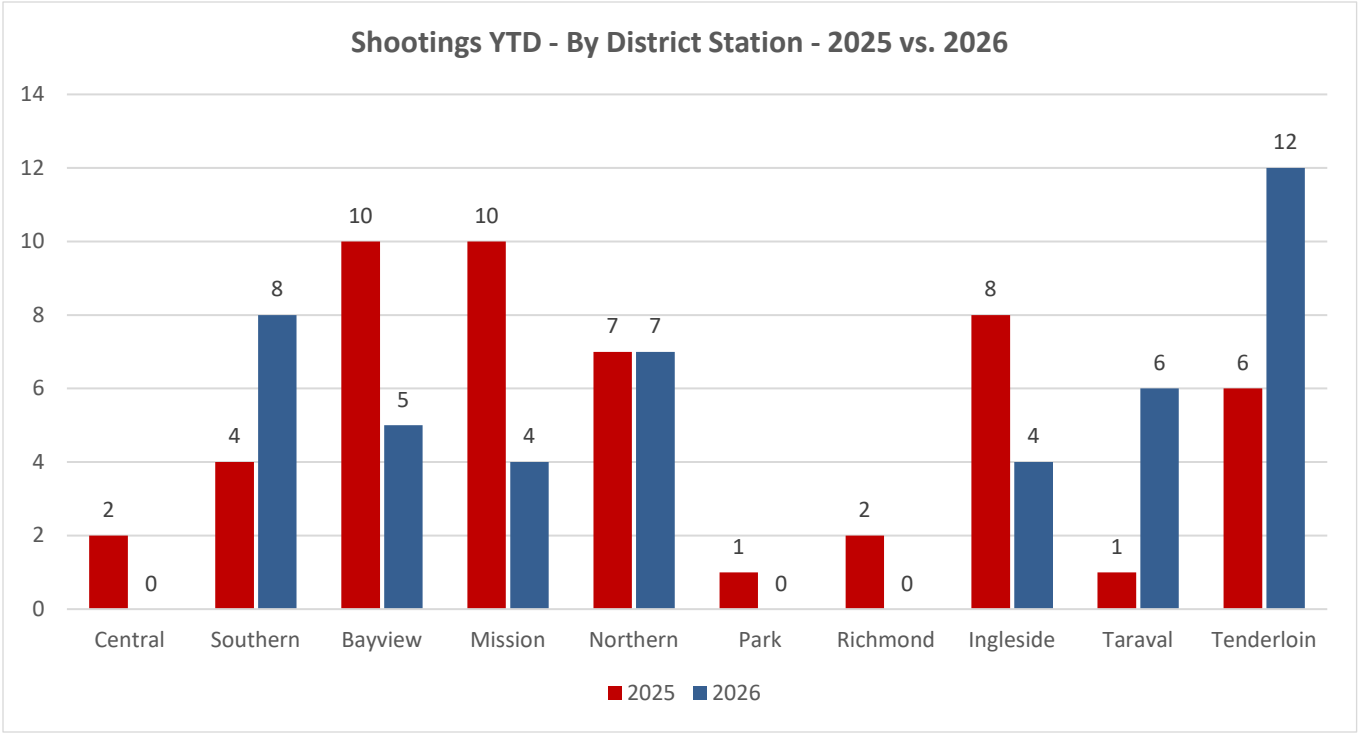
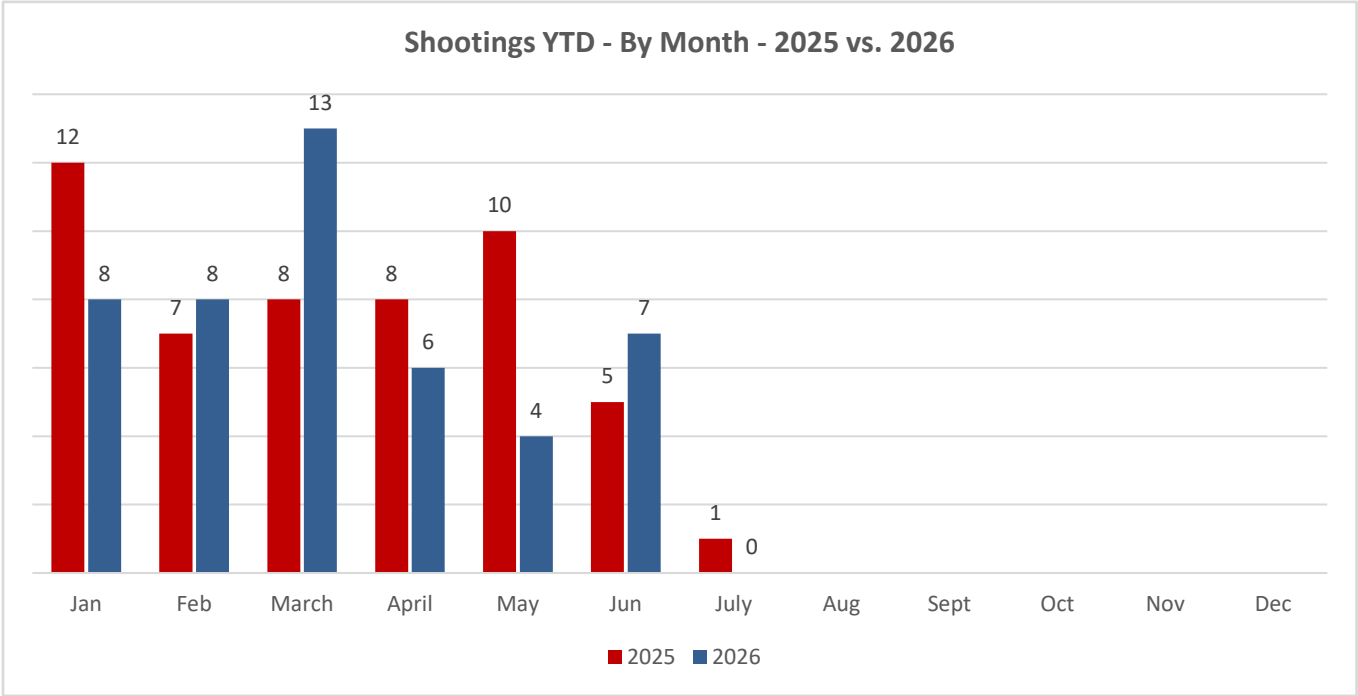
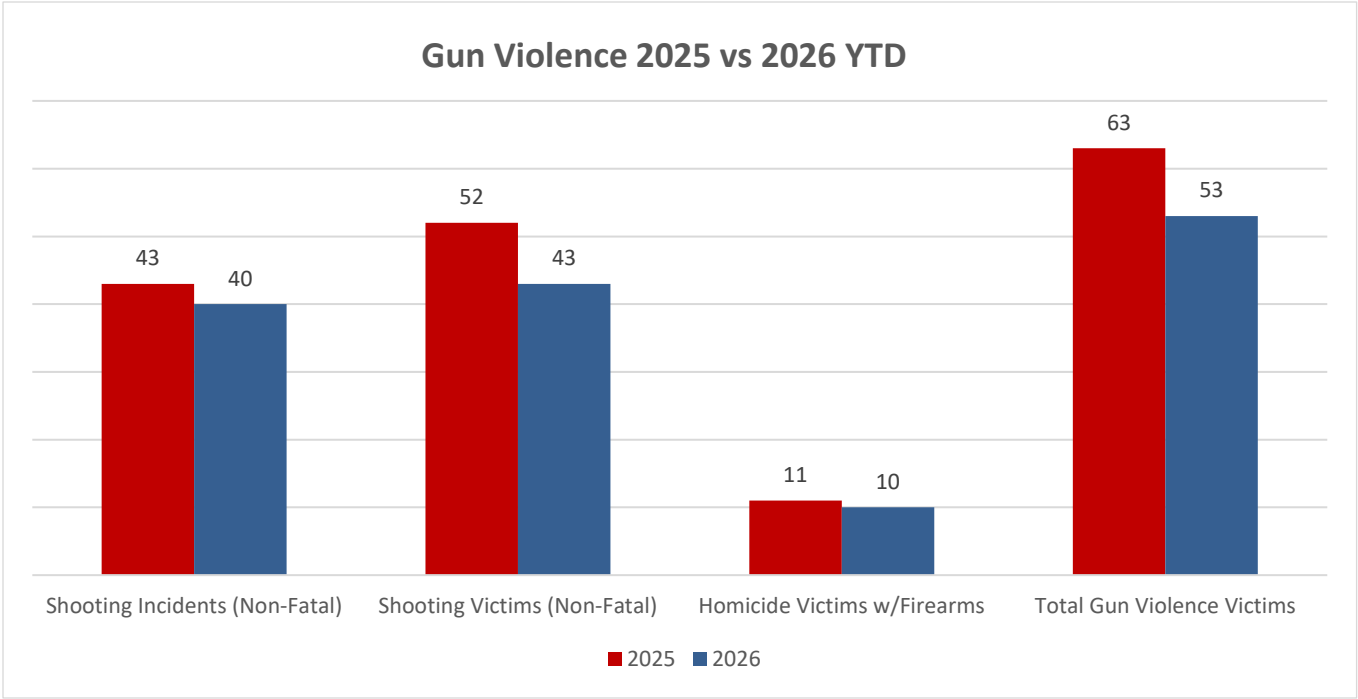
- There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 07.12.26
  - There are 16 homicides YTD with 10 resulting from a firearm.
  - There are no homicides in July 2026
  - Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 119%



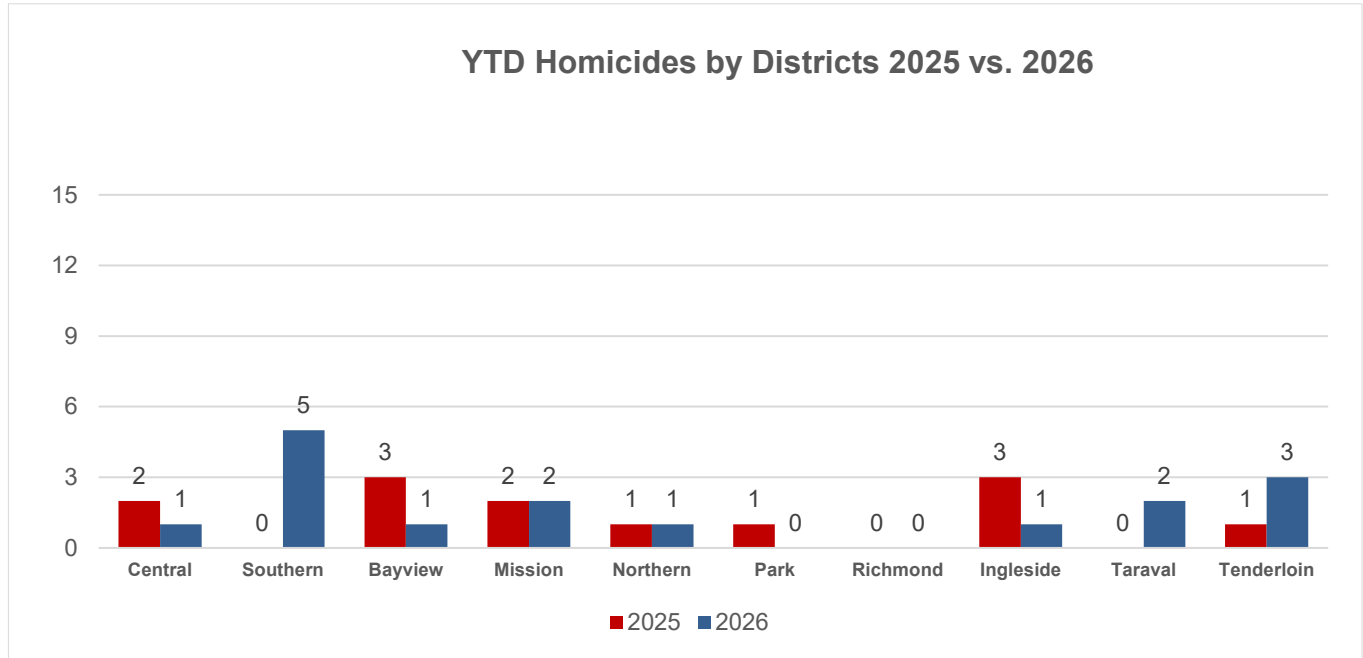
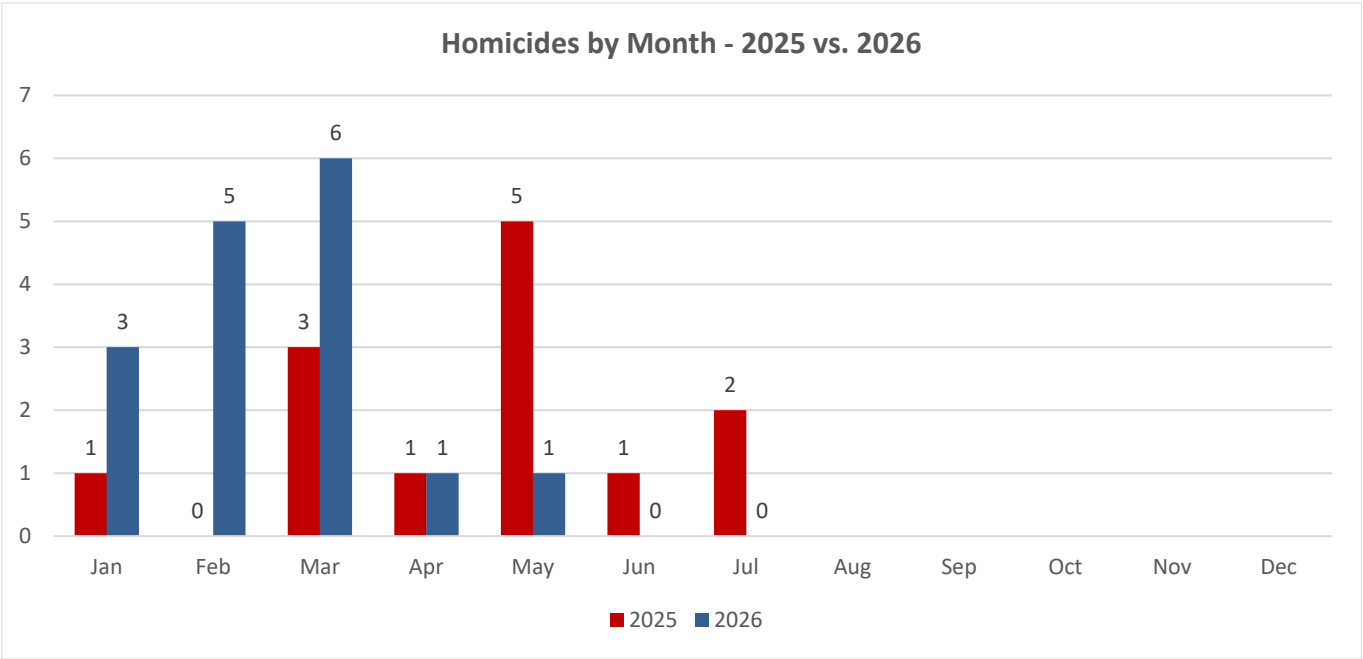
