
#### **GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 11% compared to 2021**

- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 3 individuals for the week ending 07/17/22
  - o There are a total of **99 incidents** resulting in **111 victims** YTD
- There was 1 homicide incident the week ending on 07170/2022
  - o There are **26 homicides** YTD with **18** incidents resulting from a firearm.
    - Overall Clearance Rate: 65%




