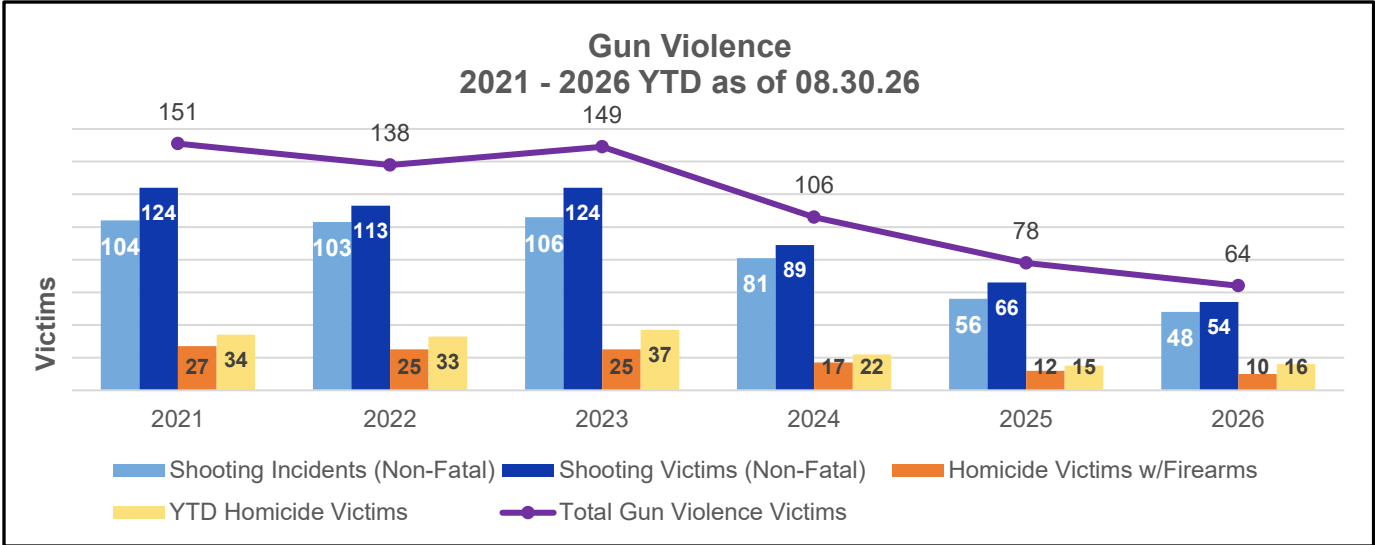
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 18% compared to 2025

- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims the week ending 08.30.26
 - There is a total of 55 fatal/non-fatal shooting incidents resulting in 64 victims; 10 homicides, 54 non-fatal

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 7% compared to 2025

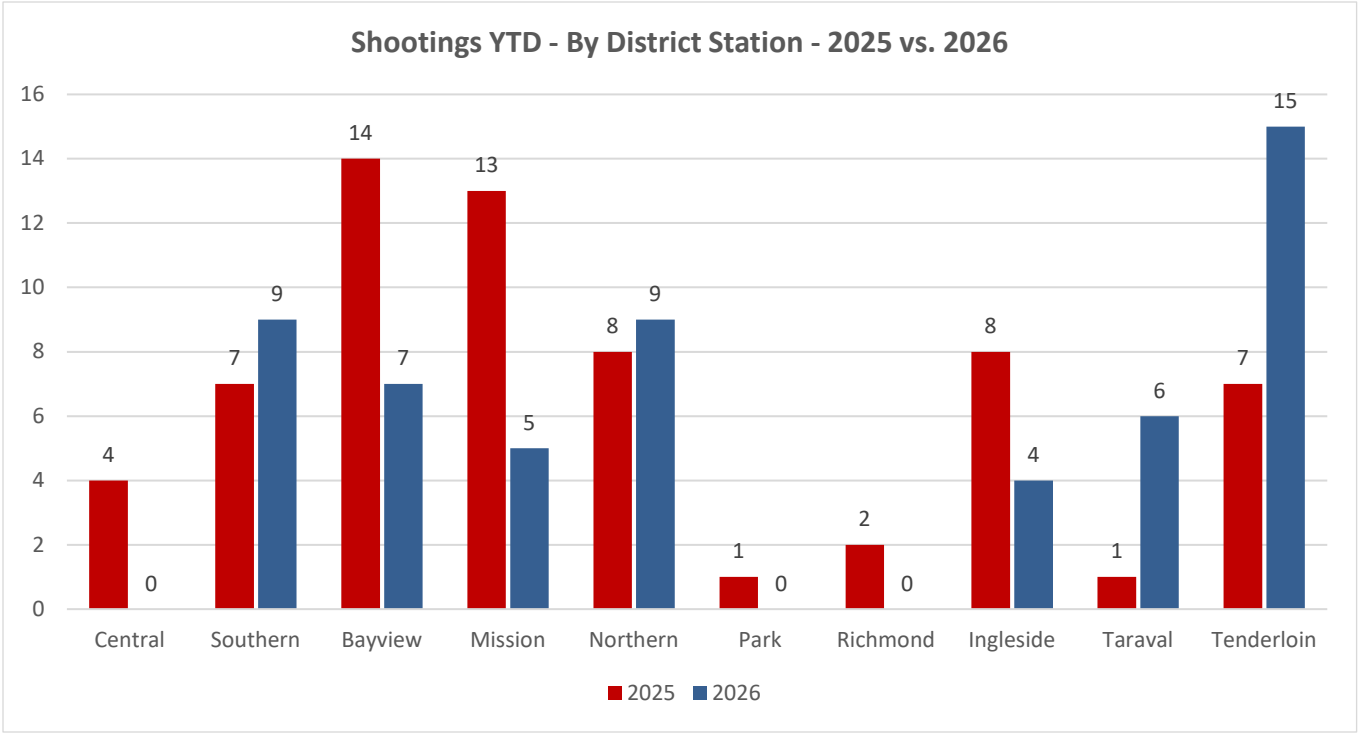
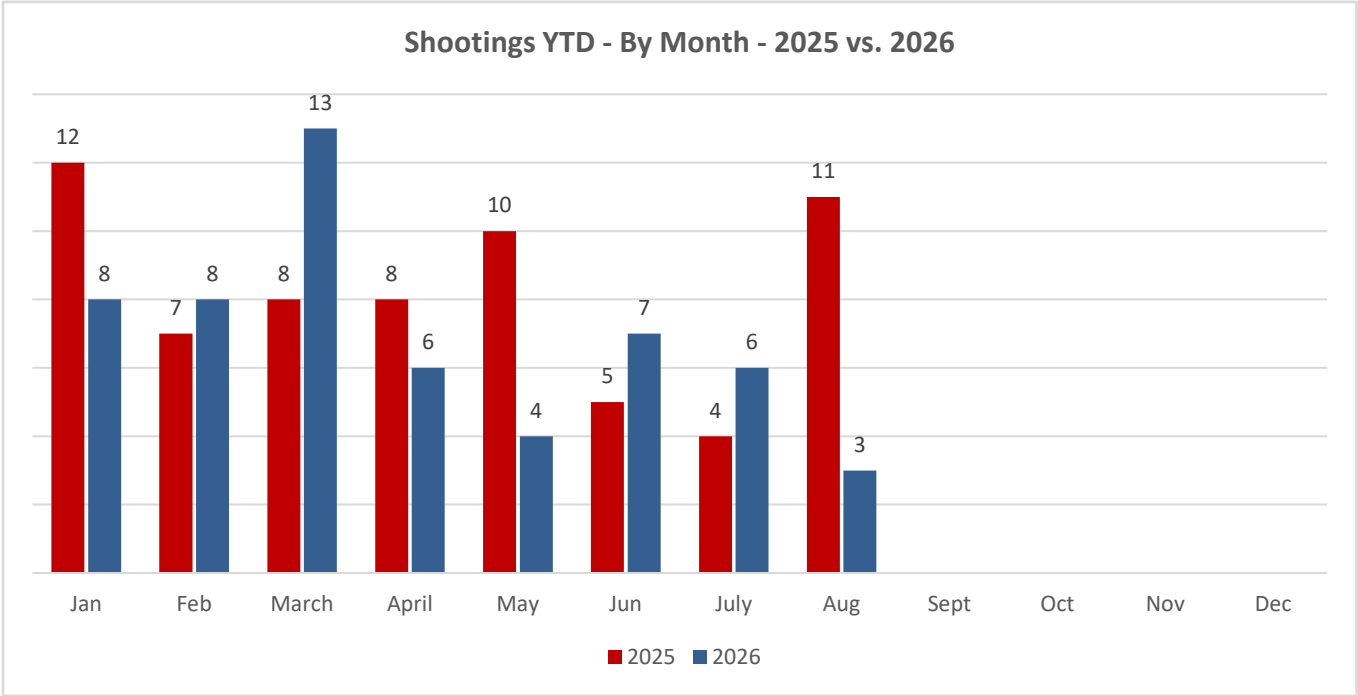
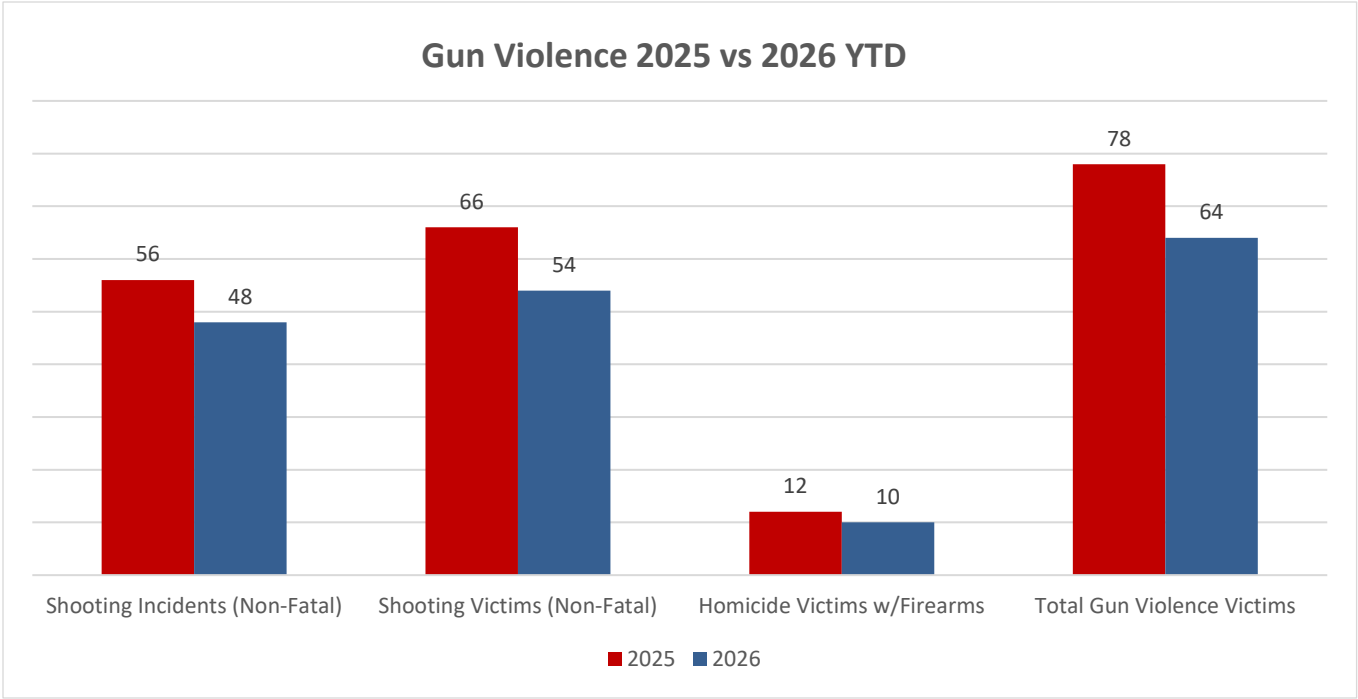
- There were **NO** homicide incidents reported the week ending 08.30.26

 - Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 144%**



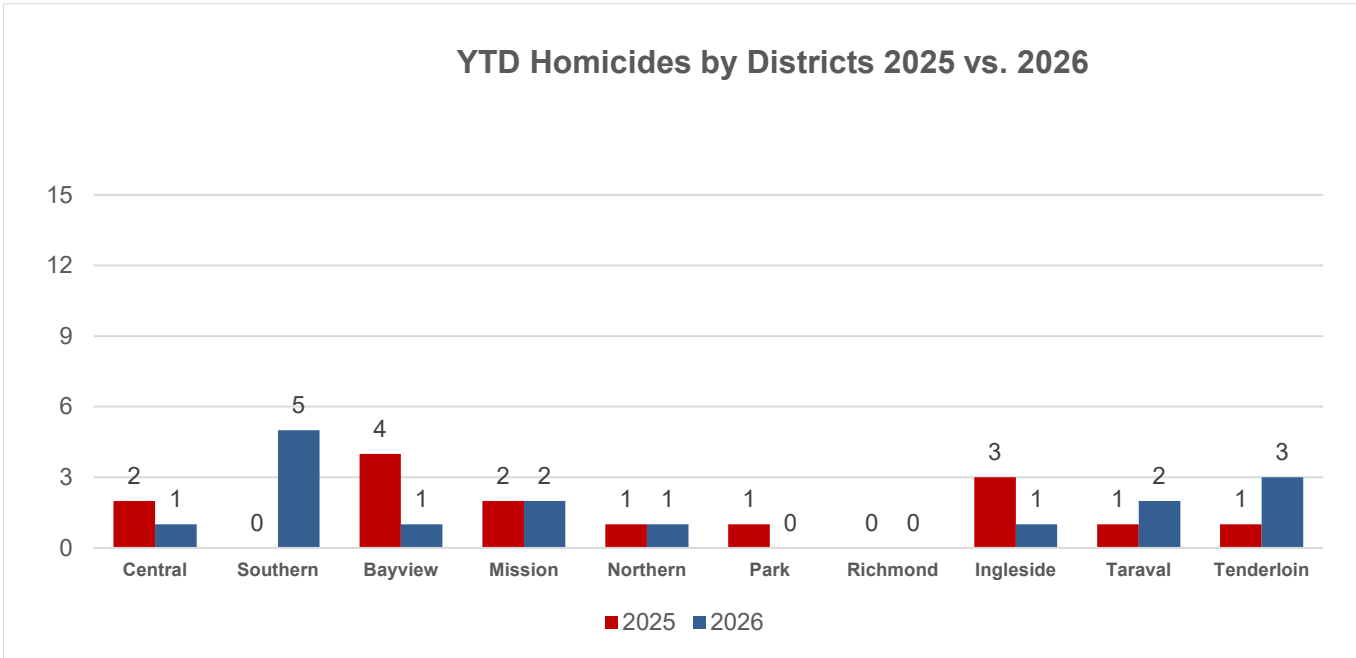
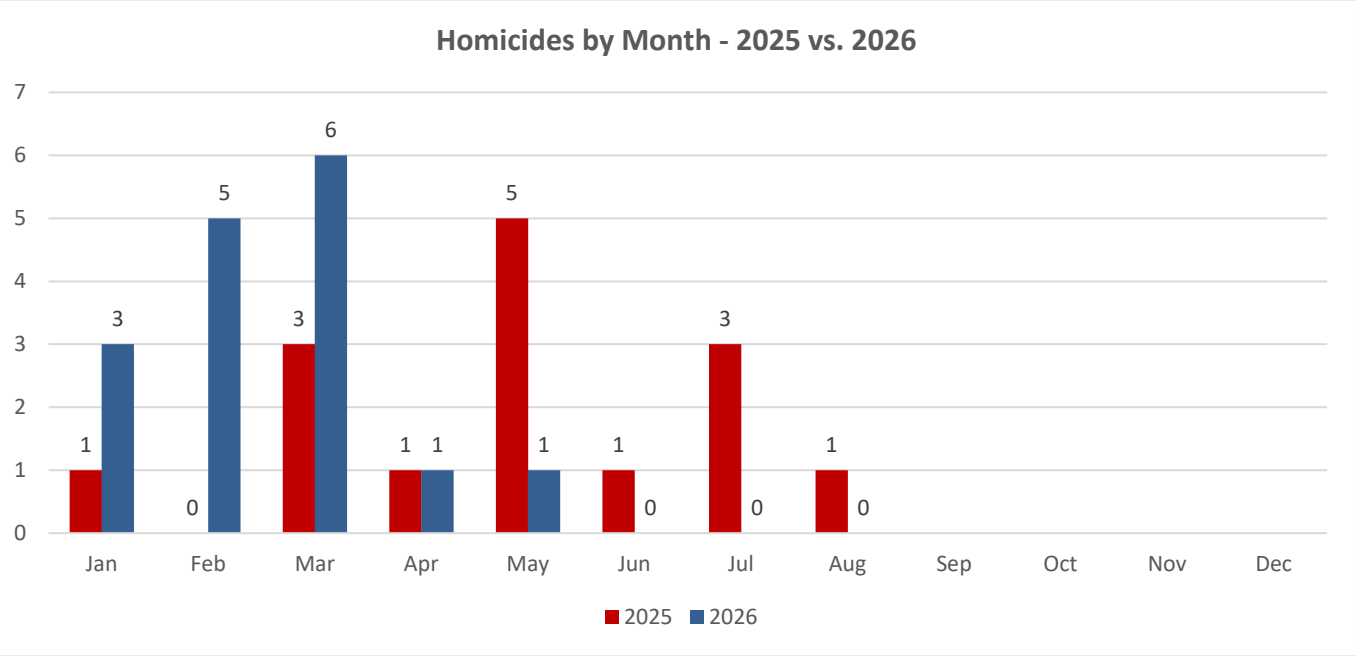
