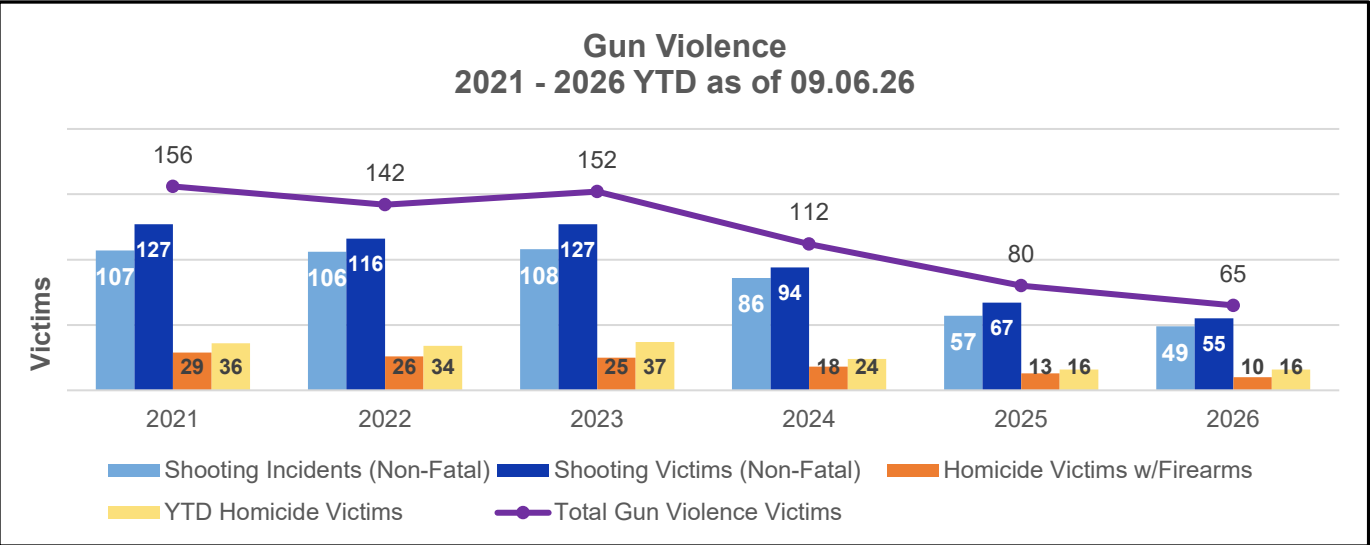
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 19% compared to 2025

- There were no shooting incidents causing injuries the week ending 09.06.26
 - There is a total of 55 fatal/non-fatal shooting incidents resulting in 64 victims; 10 homicides, 54 non-fatal

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are EVEN compared to 2025

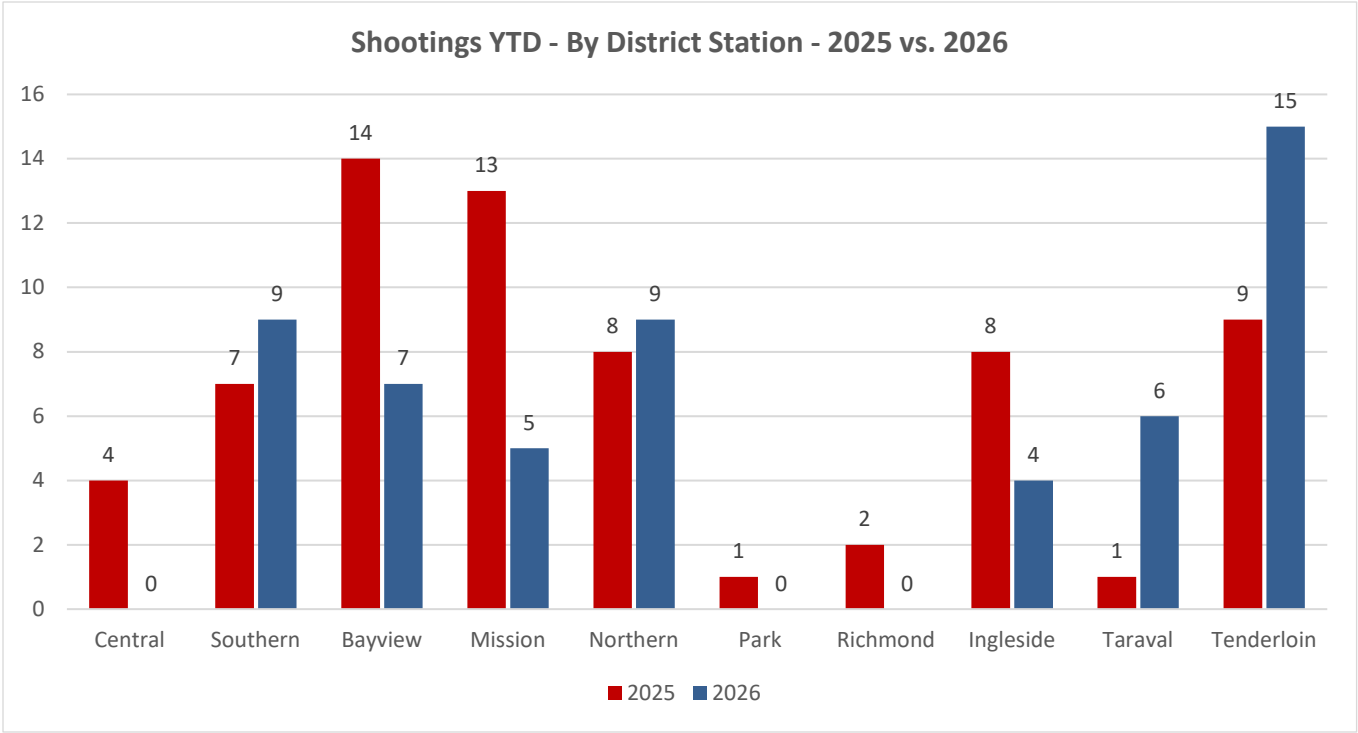
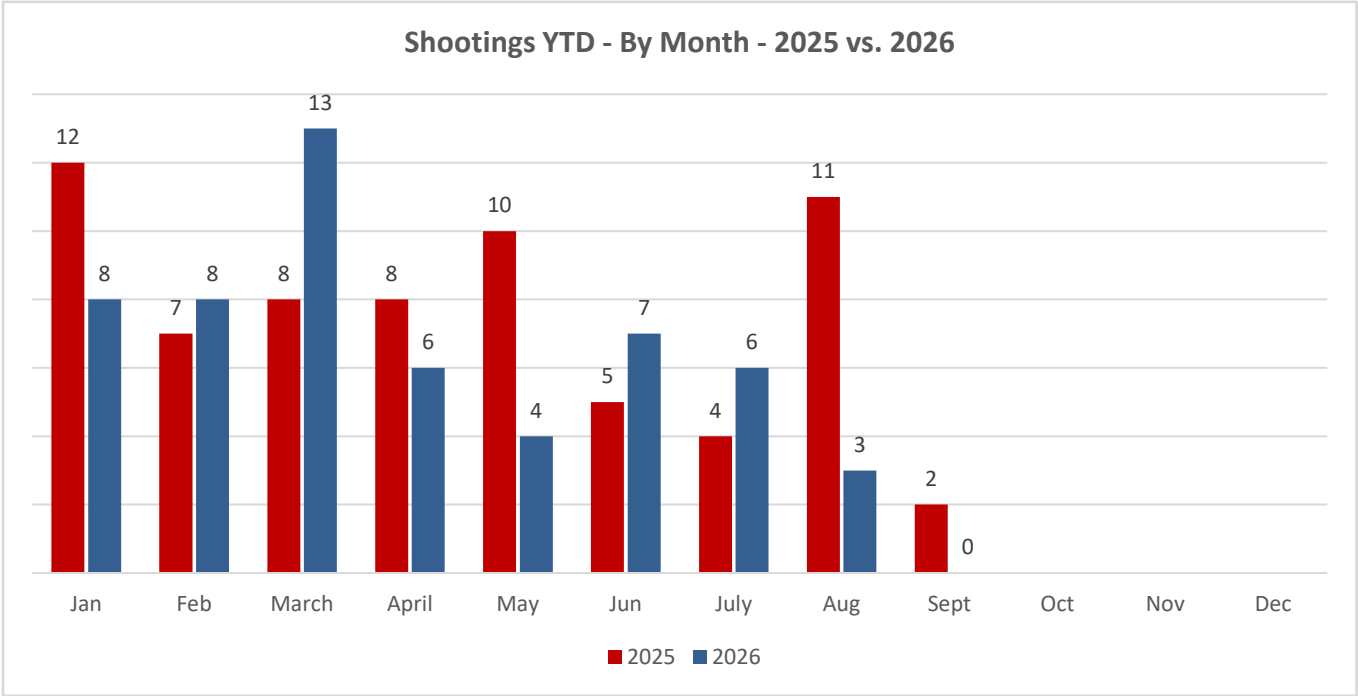
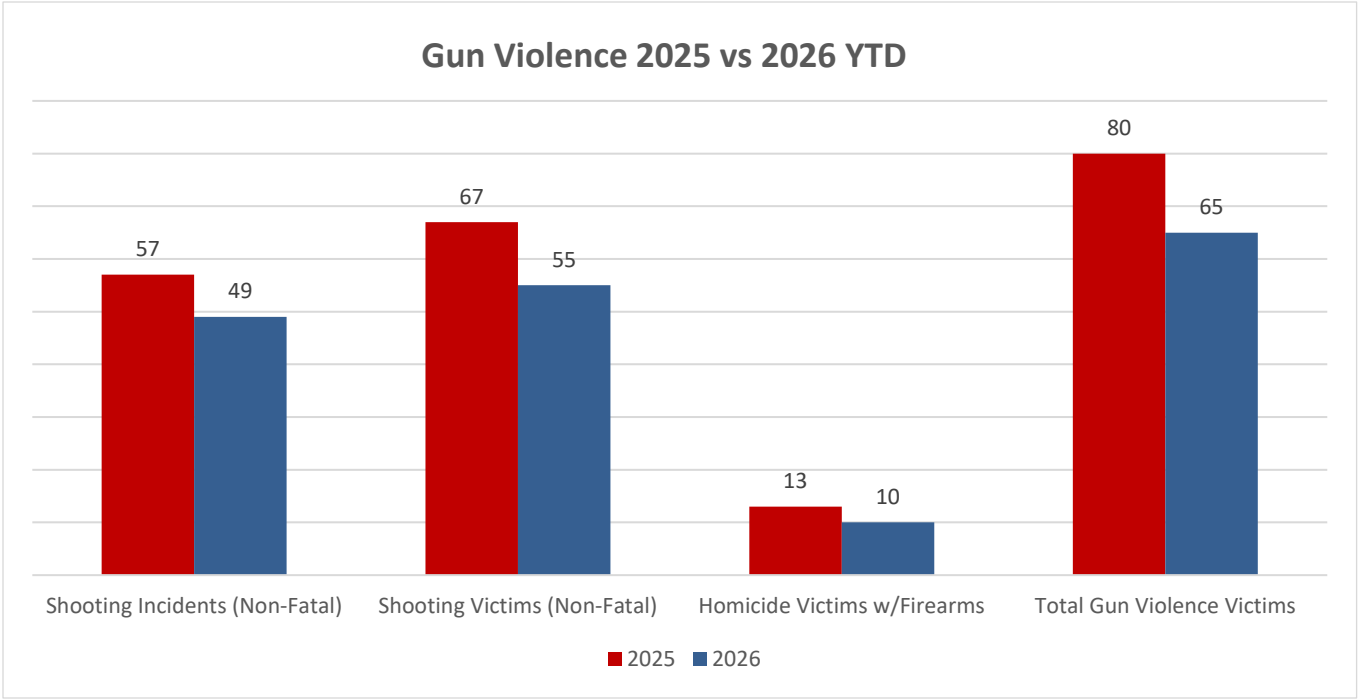
- There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 09.06.26**

 - Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 144%**



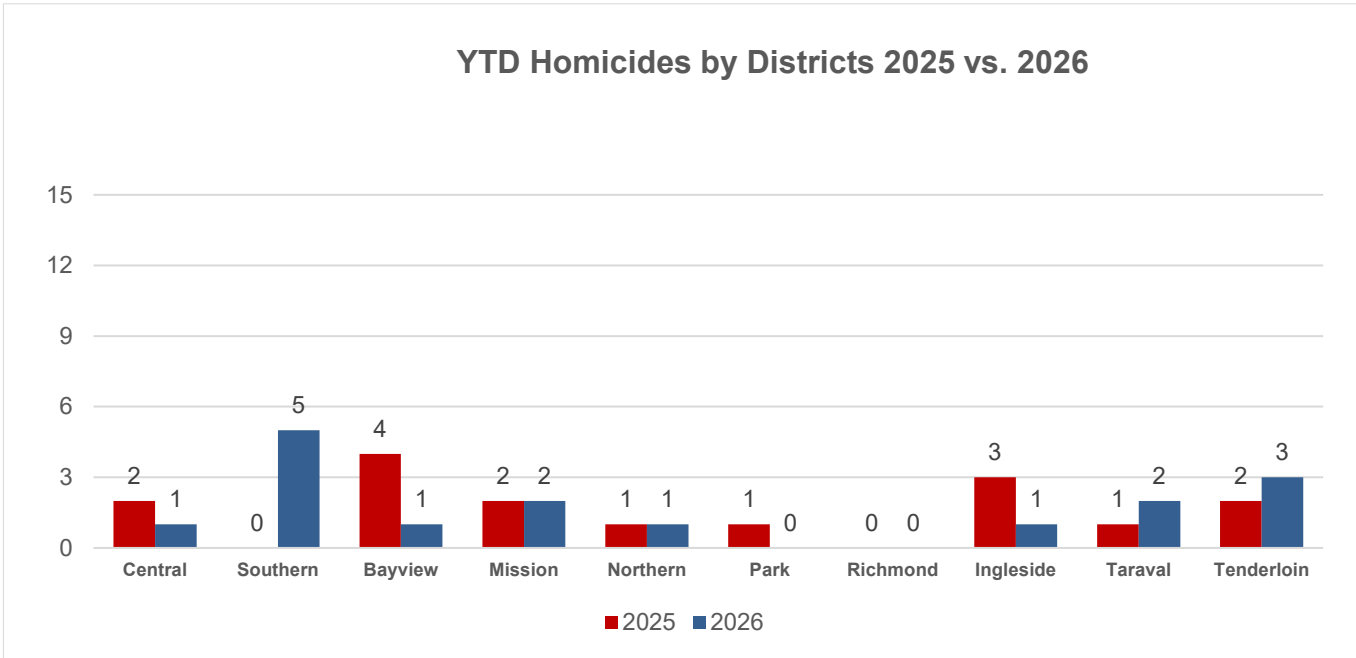
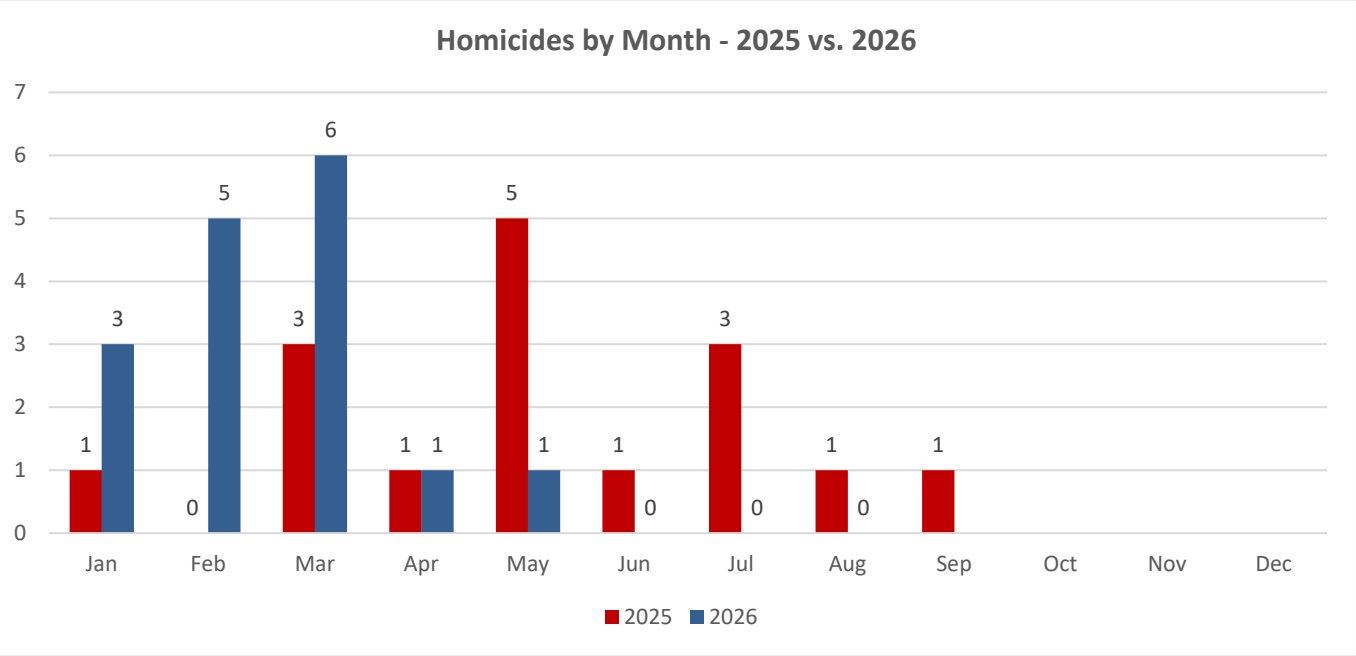
