

*Total Gun Violence = Non-fatal Shooting Victims + Fatal Shooting Victims







GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 1% compared to 2021

- There was 1 shooting incident causing injuries to 1 individual for the week ending 11/13/22
 - There are a total of 167 incidents resulting in 190 victims
- There were 3 homicide incidents reported the week ending on 11/13/22
 - There are 48 homicides YTD with 32 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 63%
