1. **Call to Order / Roll Call 2** - Meeting called to order at: 4:02pm

2. **Approval of May Meeting Minutes**  
Chester motions to approve minutes. Gaby seconds, 4 votes, minutes are approved.
3. **Review and Consideration of Agenda**  
Gaby motions to approve agenda. P seconds. 4 votes, agenda is approved.
4. **General Public Comment** – no public comment
5. **Community Input Loop Updates**  
P – Food Security Task Force was initially set to sunset on July 1<sup>st</sup>. The Board of Supervisors passed an ordinance, and the new sunset date will be June 29, 2026. The task force will have its last meeting tomorrow, June 10 at 1:30pm virtually.
6. **House Keeping**
  - a. Debrief SDDT annual meeting – On May 28<sup>th</sup> convened annual meeting at the SF LGBT Center. Speakers and panelists were SDDT funded grantees and presented their work. The latter part of the day, In Advance shared their work on the community action research. Breakout groups discussed issues related to SDDTAC structure, what gets taxed and how, where the tax money goes and relationship mapping tax success. In Advance will present more updates at the August SDDTAC meeting.
  - b. Commission Streamlining Task Force recommendations to be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors in July.
  - c. SDDT Mayor’s Proposed FY 26-27 budget allocations released on June 1<sup>st</sup>. The June SDDTAC meeting, mayor’s budget staff to share the SDDT proposed budget allocations. Members shared that glad that the proposed budget is somewhat aligned with the SDDTAC bridge plan budget recommendations but not entirely, and is disappointing that oral health is still not seen as a priority.

d. Peggy Moriarty from the Mayor's Office will present at the June SDDTAC meeting on the proposed food coordination legislation.

8. **SDDTAC Strategic Implementation Plan Review** 45 minutes

Staff shares the SDDTAC Strategic Implementation Plan strategies and goals for members to review prior to voting for approval at the June SDDTAC meeting. The plan is an evolving document however the strategies and goals remain, as well as the mission, vision, values and priority populations. The strategies include:

**Policy/revenue protection:** focuses on protecting, strengthening, and potentially increasing soda tax revenue by advancing policy, improving budget accountability, and reducing threats to long-term funding stability.

**Data and Evidence:** focuses on using data, evaluation, research, and community-informed learning to guide recommendations, measure impact, and strengthen accountability.

**Collaboration/Collective Impact:** focuses on building partnerships, aligning with community and cross-sector efforts, and strengthening collective action to advance chronic disease prevention and health equity.

**Education and Awareness:** focuses on increasing awareness of the soda tax, SDDTAC's role, and the impact of funded investments among decision-makers, partners, and the broader public.

**Governance:** focuses on building and sustaining the structures, processes, leadership, and administrative support needed for SDDTAC to operate effectively, equitably, and consistently over time.
