In January, we added an additional VSR at the SFVAMC to alleviate heavy traffic and to assist John Gallagher. Since we now have our SME, Elvie Flaviano, on the ground, we expect to speed up the process and increase claims submission. We plan to continue supporting the SFVAMC as long as we have the resources and backing of SFVAMC leadership. This is a work in progress, and we will continue to work to make it more efficient for our staff to ensure they are supported.

Last month, our data showed a 10 percent significant increase in benefits awarded. Our staff are constantly posting awards, updating the VP to ensure nothing is missed. Although scheduled in-person appointments decreased, virtual appointments increased from 89 to 111. The total claims filed totaled 558. This February, we are attending the Mental Health Summit hosted by Swords to Plowshares. We will reestablish and continue our collaboration on the San Francisco State University campus. We will also re-establish the City College of San





Francisco Veterans Resource Center to provide student veterans with the resources they need regarding their benefits and initiate workshops at the beginning of fall and summer classes and provide resources for both colleges monthly.
