The month of July was particularly busy for our office, and our workload continues to increase as we diligently process and submit claims on behalf of the veterans we serve. A notable achievement during this period was reaching a total of \$1,058,774.41 in benefits awarded. This represents a significant milestone, marking the first time the San Francisco County Veterans Service Office has achieved this level of benefits awarded.

During July, the San Francisco County Veterans Service Office began transitioning to the new area code and updated phone number. This migration is progressing gradually, and we are in the process of updating our business cards, flyers, and website to reflect the change. In preparation for Fleet Week, we are also coordinating with the city's design team to produce new tablecloths, canopy, and promotional materials. As this design and production process





requires additional time, we anticipate that these items will be completed by October.

On June 8, 2026, I was selected to lead the San Francisco County Veterans Service Office (SFCVSO). I am grateful, humbled, and honored to serve as the County Veterans Service Officer. My vision for the office is to ensure that all veterans and their dependents clearly understand and successfully access federal, state, and local entitlements. This includes maintaining a highly trained and accredited staff capable of navigating complex VA regulations, while actively engaging underserved, disabled, and homeless veterans within the community. Additionally, I am committed to expanding outreach efforts to support LGBTQ+ veterans throughout San Francisco and surrounding areas. Ultimately, I aim to achieve this vision through strong advocacy, streamlined claims processing, and proactive community engagement.
