



Current San Francisco DJJ Realignment Population

- Probation Caseload:
 - 73 youth have prior sustained 707(b) petitions (25.8% of total probation caseload, excluding AB12)
- Commitments:
 - Secure Youth Treatment Facility (SYTF): 12 young people currently committed to SYTF
 - Base Term Range: 2-7 years
 - Less Restrictive Programs: 4 young people currently in LRPs
 - Living independently, living with family, and in structured residential programs

Programmatic Updates

- Culinary Arts CTE Program Cohort commenced January 2026
- Now in contract with two structured residential LRPs
- Short-term contract for intensive sex offender services executed; RFP for longer term services to be released in April 2026




DJJ Realignment Plan - Overview

- Revamped submission in 2025, so 2026 submission is similar with the following updates:
 - Updated required data for FY 2024-2025
 - Career Technical Education/vocational program offerings
 - Reentry Services programs
 - Less Restrictive Programs that SF is using when youth step down from their commitments.
 - New required section: JJRBG expenditures from FY 24-25 (Part 10)
